



Assembly Line Cardmaking

Special Edition Baby Botanicals

Baby Botanicals Materials:

- Greetings to Go
- Fibers and Ribbon from *Baby Botanicals* Collection

Tools and Supplies:

- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive
- Tape
- Foam Adhesive
- 3x14" CS® Grid Ruler
- Scissors
- Ranger Stickles™ Glitter Glue – Frosted Lace
- Purple Gel Pen
- Postage-edge Decorative Scissors

Preparation:

1. Trim the White Printed Cutaparts into sections as indicated by the artwork. The trimming guidelines do not subdivide each panel into four separate sections. If desired, trim the individual images to 1½x2½".
2. Score and fold each 5.5x8.5 Yellow card base horizontally at 4.25".
3. If you do not have an item to complete the card as shown, simply omit or substitute the item.
4. Adhere the "Congratulations on your special delivery!" cutpart to the inside of each folded card.



Card 1



Notes: Adhere each cutapart to the Lilac panel; outline the letters of each word with Glitter Glue.

Card 2



Notes: Tape a loop of white ruffle-edged ribbon to the back of each cutapart; adhere to the Lilac panel with foam adhesive.

Card 3



Notes: Adhere three of the four cutaparts to the bottom of a horizontal Lilac panel; tie a bow with yellow jute; attach the fourth cutapart to the inside of the card along with the sentiment.



Notes: Adhere the cutaparts to the Lilac panel; draw small, angled lines around the perimeter of each cutapart with a purple gel pen to create faux stitching.

Notes: Adhere the cutaparts to the Lilac panel; wrap yellow jute vertically and horizontally around the panel and tie a bow in the center; attach a quilted gingham heart sticker to the upper left cutpart.



Card 6



Notes: Tear away the four outside edges from the Lilac panel; attach the cutaparts to the center of the panel and nest onto the card base.
