Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

Trim the 12x12 Cutaparts according to the guidelines. Many of the White cutaparts nest onto the Citrus Cutaparts.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.



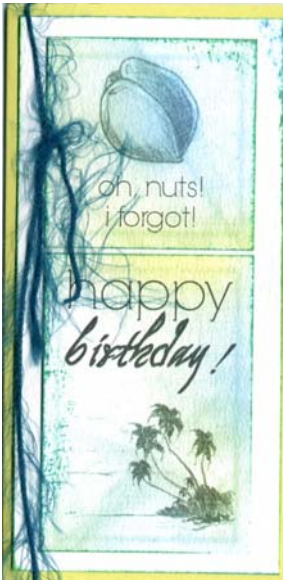
Set A: 3-1/4 x 6-1/4" Tri-Fold Citrus Cards with (2) 2-7/8 x 6" White Panels

Card #1



- Citrus Card with White Panels
 - Wood Mounted "Coconut Anatomy" Stamp
1. Stamp the WM image with Onyx ink onto one White panel. Fill in the image with watercolor and splatter the background.
 2. Create a watercolor border on the White panel, and attach to the Citrus card. Add the second White panel to the inside of the card and stamp an appropriate greeting.

Card #2



- Citrus Card with White Panels
 - White Cutaparts: "Happy Birthday!" and "Oh, Nuts!"
 - Teal Eyelash Fiber
1. Attach the cutaparts to one White panel, as shown, and layer the panel onto the front of the card.
 2. Tie the fiber around the left fold of the card, and attach the remaining White panel to the inside of the fold.

Card #3



- Citrus Card with White Panels
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - White Cutapart: "Big Thanks!"
1. Stamp the set of three fish onto the right side of one White panel with Onyx ink.
 2. Attach the cutapart to the left side of the panel with foam adhesive and layer onto the front of the card.
 3. Attach the remaining panel to the inside of the card.



Card #4



- Citrus Card with White Panels
 - WM "Big Thanks!" Stamp
1. Stamp "Big Thanks!" onto the upper center of one White panel with Waterfall ink. Without re-inking, stamp repeatedly down the panel, as shown. Ink the stamp again, stamp off once onto scratch paper, and stamp twice above the full strength image.
 2. Splatter the panel with watercolors and attach the panel to the card. Adhere the second panel inside the card, stamping as desired.

Card #5



- Citrus Card with White Panels
 - White Cutapart: "Go Nuts"
 - Handmade Teal Panel (From Set C)
 - (3) Mini Brads
1. Tear the edges of the cutapart and soak with watercolor. Attach to the upper center of one White panel with foam adhesive.
 2. Tear a narrow strip from the long edge of a Handmade Teal panel. Wrap the strip around the bottom portion of the White panel and secure with three mini brads.
 3. Layer the panel onto the card; attach the second White panel to the inside.

Set B: 4-1/2 x 6-1/4" Teal Cards with 4-1/4 x 6" White Panels and 3-3/4 x 5-1/2" Citrus Panels
Card #1



- Teal Card with White and Citrus Panels
 - Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds
1. Ink the UM turtle image with the Big 'n Juicy pad or your favorite dye base inks. Spray lightly with water and stamp onto the center of a White panel. Spray and stamp two additional times without re-inking.
 2. Stamp the UM verse onto the panel and attach the panel to the card. Layer the Citrus panel to the inside of the card.



Card #2



- Teal Card with White and Citrus Panels
- UM Font
- White Cutapart: "Have a Whale of a Big Day"
- (2) Mini Brads
- Teal Grosgrain Ribbon

1. Calculate the space needed to accommodate the White cutapart on the Citrus panel. Stamp the UM bracket image onto the left and right cutapart area with Onyx ink. Set a brad into the point of each bracket.
2. Attach the cutapart to the center of the Citrus panel and wrap a length of Teal grosgrain ribbon around the bottom of the panel, securing ends with adhesive. Tie a small ribbon bow, and attach to the ribbon.
3. Layer the White panel inside the Teal card.

Card #3



- Teal Card with White and Citrus Panels
- WM "Coconut Anatomy" Stamp
- WM "Big Thanks!" Stamp

1. Lightly spray the WM "Coconut Anatomy" stamp with water. Color directly onto the stamp with watercolor crayons. Stamp onto the Citrus panel.
2. Stamp "Big Thanks!" onto the panel with Onyx ink. Splatter color onto the panel with watercolors. Attach the panel to the Card.
3. Layer the White panel onto the inside of the card.

Card #4



- Teal Card with White and Citrus Panels
- White Cutapart: "Get Well Soon"
- Citrus Cutapart
- Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds

1. Nest the White cutapart onto the corresponding Citrus cutapart with foam adhesive. Attach to the upper portion of the White panel.
2. Stamp the UM quote onto the bottom portion of the panel with Onyx ink; attach the panel to the card.
3. Layer the Citrus panel to the inside of the card.



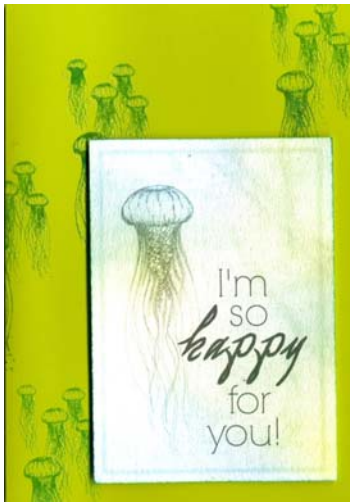
Card #5



- Teal Card with White and Citrus Panels
 - White Cutaparts: "Happy Anniversary" and Starfish
 - Citrus Cutapart
 - (4) Mini Brads
1. Attach the White cutapart to the corresponding Citrus cutapart with foam adhesive. Set four mini brads into each corner of the Citrus cutapart; layer onto the Citrus panel.
 2. Attach the White cutapart to the bottom portion of the Citrus panel, and attach to the card.
 3. Layer the White panel to the inside of the card.

Set C: 5 x 7" Lime Cards with 4-1/2 x 6-1/2 Handmade Teal Panels

Card #1



- Lime Card
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - White Cutapart: "I'm So Happy for You!"
1. Stamp the UM jellyfish image several times onto the Lime card with dye base ink. Sprinkle with clear embossing powder, shake off excess, and melt powder with a heat tool.
 2. Attach the White cutapart to the card with foam adhesive.

Card #2



- Lime Card with Handmade Teal Panel
 - White Cutaparts: "Hello!" and "Thank You"
 - Citrus Cutapart
 - (2) Mini Brads
1. Layer the White cutapart onto the Citrus cutapart at an angle with foam adhesive.
 2. Layer the nested cutaparts onto the Handmade Teal panel. Attach the "thank you" image to the bottom of the panel with mini brads.
 3. Layer the panel onto the card.



Card #3



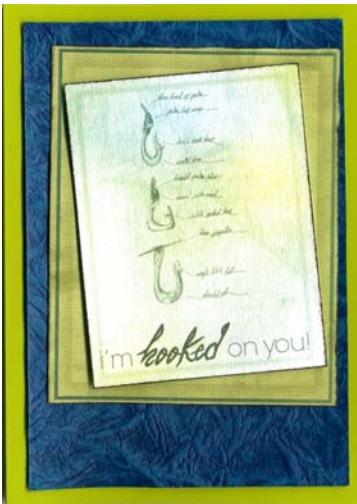
- Lime Card with Handmade Teal Panel
 - Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds
 - White Cutapart: "Congratulations!"
1. Stamp the UM oyster image onto the Lime card several times with dye ink. Emboss with clear powder to set ink.
 2. Trim the Handmade Teal panel slightly larger than the White cutapart; nest and attach to the Lime card with foam adhesive.

Card #4



- Lime Card with Handmade Teal Panel
 - White Cutapart: "Hope You're Feeling Better Soon"
1. Tear three strips from the Handmade Teal panel and attach to the Lime card, as shown.
 2. Layer the White cutpart onto the card with foam adhesive.

Card #5



- Lime Card with Handmade Teal Panel
 - White Cutapart: "I'm Hooked on You!"
 - Citrus Cutapart
1. Layer the White cutpart onto the Citrus Cutapart with foam adhesive.
 2. Attach the nested cutaparts to the Handmade Teal panel and layer onto the card.
