## February 2012 *Greetings to Go* Full Circle

### Materials:

- *Full Circle* Greetings to Go
- *Full Circle* Unmounted (UM) Borders & Backgrounds and FontArt
- *Full Circle* Unmounted Greeting and Art Nouveau
- *Full Circle* Club Scrap® Unmounted Stamps

### Tools and Supplies:

- 12" Paper Trimmer
- CS® Grid Ruler
- CS® Ruby, Earth, India Black, Sapphire, Topaz and Moss Inks
- Faber-Castell Watercolor Pencils
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Foam Adhesive
- Stapler and Staples
- Crop-A-Dile
- Tonic Paper Distressing Tool
- Waterbrush
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat
- Corner Rounder Punch
- Scrap Paper

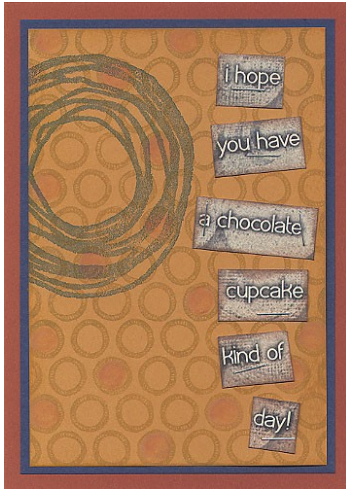
*Trim the Tan and Celery cutaparts into sections as indicated by the cutting guidelines and artwork.*

*If you do not have an item required to complete a card, simply omit the step or substitute the item.*



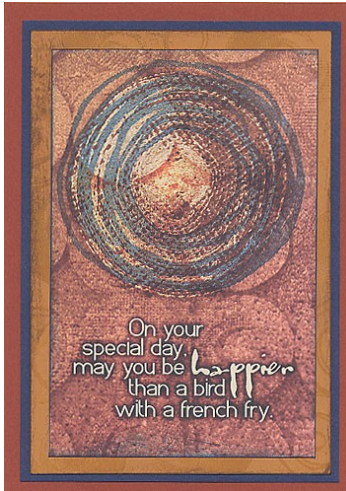
**Set A: 5x7" Clay Cards with 4½x6½" Blue and 4¼x6¼" Caramel Panels**

**Card #1**



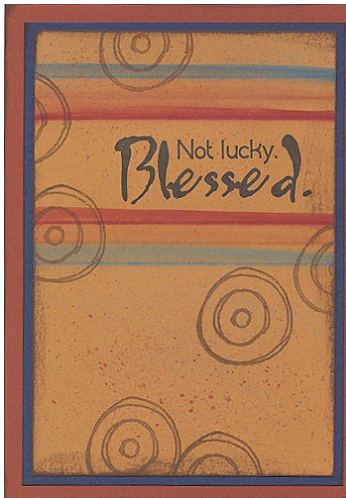
- Clay Card with Blue and Caramel Panels
  - Sand Cutaparts: "I Hope You Have a Chocolate Cupcake Kind of Day!"
  - Club Scrap UM Stamps
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM circle pattern image onto the Caramel panel with Topaz ink. Color random circles with a watercolor pencil and blend with a waterbrush.
  2. Stamp the large UM circle onto the panel with Sapphire ink.
  3. Trim apart the words on the cutapart and staple onto the panel.
  4. Nest the Caramel and Blue panels onto the card.

**Card #2**



- Clay Card with Blue and Caramel Panels
  - Sand Cutapart: "On Your Special Day . . ."
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the large UM circle image onto the cutapart.
  2. Nest the cutapart onto the Caramel and Blue panels and attach to the card.

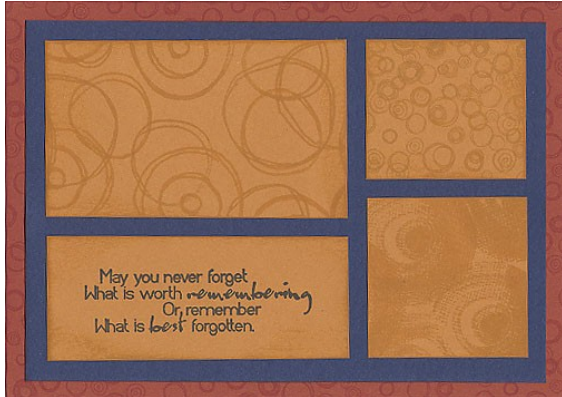
**Card #3**



- Clay Card with Blue and Caramel Panels
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM quote onto the Caramel panel with India Black ink.
  2. Use a ruler to add three straight lines with watercolor pencils above and below the stamped quote. Draw each line 1/4" apart. Blend the lines with a waterbrush. Splatter the panel with additional watercolors.
  3. Stamp the UM triple circle image onto the panel with Earth ink.
  4. Layer the Caramel and Blue panels onto the card.

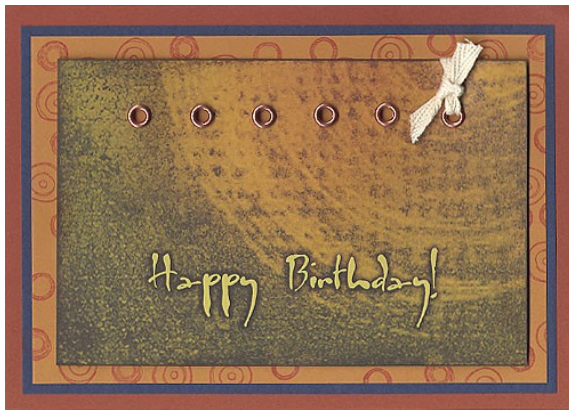


#### Card #4



- Clay Card with Blue and Caramel Panels
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Trim the Caramel panel horizontally at 5.75 and 3.75". Cut the 3.75x4.25 horizontally at 3.75 and 2.25". Trim the 2x4.25 panel horizontally at 1.75".
  2. Stamp each trimmed Caramel panel with a different UM image and Topaz ink. Stamp the quote onto the 1.5x3.75" panel with India Black ink.
  3. Arrange the Caramel panels onto the Blue panel with equal spacing and attach to the card.

#### Card #5



- Clay Card with Blue and Caramel Panels
  - Celery Cutapart: "Happy Birthday"
  - (6) Copper Eyelets
  - Twill
  - UM Greeting
1. Stamp the UM circle border onto the Caramel panel with Ruby ink. (The Ruby ink will look great on the Caramel paper . . . no worries!)
  2. Set the six eyelets in a row onto the Celery cutapart. Tie a piece of twill around one of the eyelets.
  3. Layer the cutapart onto the Celery panel with foam adhesive and attach to the Blue panel and card.

#### Set B: 4½x6¼" Sand Double Flap Cards with 2¾x6 and 1¾x6" Celery Panels

#### Card #1

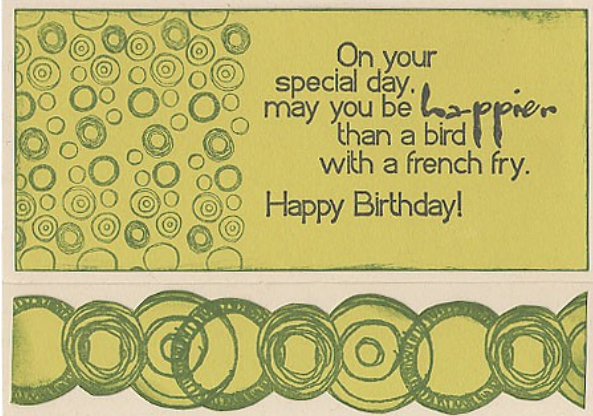


- Sand Card with Celery Panels
  - Celery Cutaparts: "A Smile . . ." and "Wear It Every Day"
  - (2) Copper Eyelets
1. Nest the perfectly-sized cutaparts onto the Celery panels.
  2. Set an eyelet into a circle on each panel and layer the panels onto the card flaps.



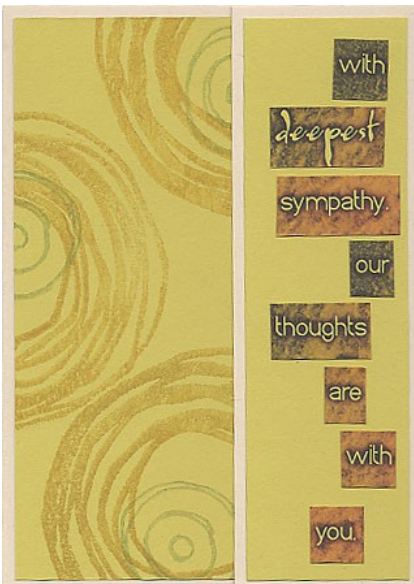


**Card #2**



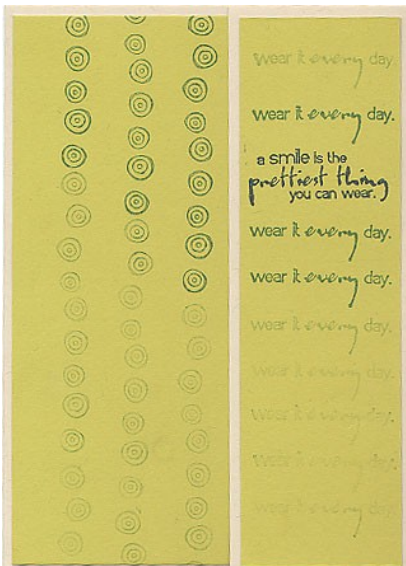
- Sand Card with Celery Panels
  - UM Greeting
  - Club Scrap UM Stamps
1. Stamp the UM birthday greeting onto the large Celery panel with India Black ink. Stamp the small UM circle border image onto the left side of the panel with Moss ink.
  2. Stamp the large UM circle trio onto the narrow Celery panel with Moss ink, repeating the image to create a row. Use a craft knife and cutting mat to cut along the edges of the image.
  3. Layer the panels onto the card flaps.

**Card #3**



- Sand Card with Celery Panels
  - Sand Cutaparts: "With Deepest Sympathy" and "Our Thoughts Are With You"
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Trim the Sand cutaparts into individual words. Adhere to the narrow Celery panel.
  2. Stamp the large UM circle onto the wide Celery panel with Topaz ink. Stamp the small UM circle with Moss ink. (Stamp off once onto scrap paper to achieve a lighter color.)
  3. Nest the panels onto the card flaps.

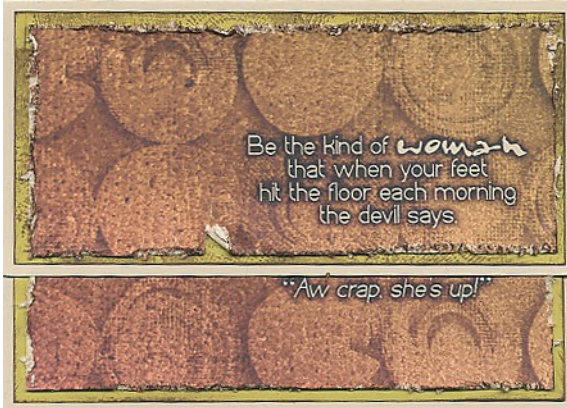
**Card #4**



- Sand Card with Celery Panels
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - UM Greeting
1. Stamp the UM "smile" quote onto the narrow Celery panel with India Black ink. Stamp the UM "wear it every day" quote above and below the "smile" quote with Moss ink. Stamp again several times above and below without re-inking.
  2. Stamp the UM circle border onto the wide Celery panel with Moss ink. Stamp "full strength" along the top edge and stamp half strength to complete the row beneath.
  3. Adhere the panels to the card flaps.



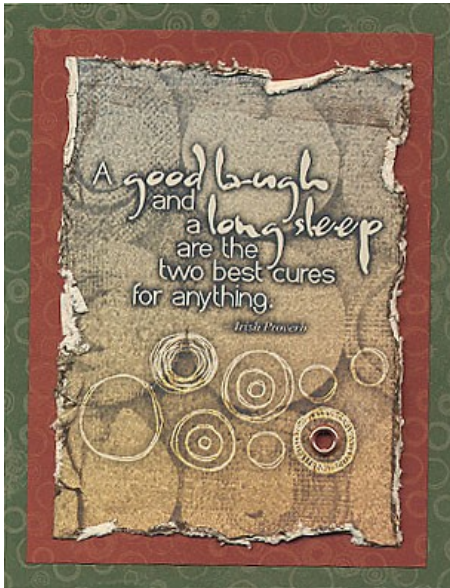
### Card #5



- Sand Card with Celery Panels
  - Sand Cutaparts: “Be the Kind of Woman” and “She’s Up!”
1. Distress the edges of the Sand cutaparts and nest onto the Celery panels. Attach the panels to the card.

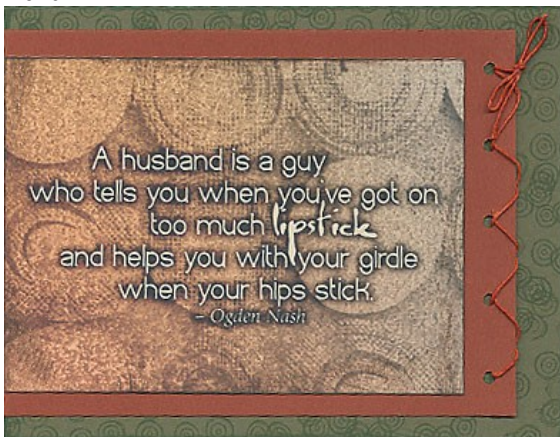
### Set C: 4¼x5½” Green Cards with 3¾x5” Clay Panels

#### Card #1



- Green Card with Clay Panel
  - Sand Cutapart: “A Good Laugh . . .”
  - Copper Eyelet
  - UM Art Nouveau
1. Stamp the UM reverse circle pattern image onto the Clay panel with Ruby ink. Stamp onto the Green panel with Moss ink.
  2. Distress the edges of the Sand cutapart. Set an eyelet into the lower right corner. Nest the cutapart onto the panel and card.

#### Card #2

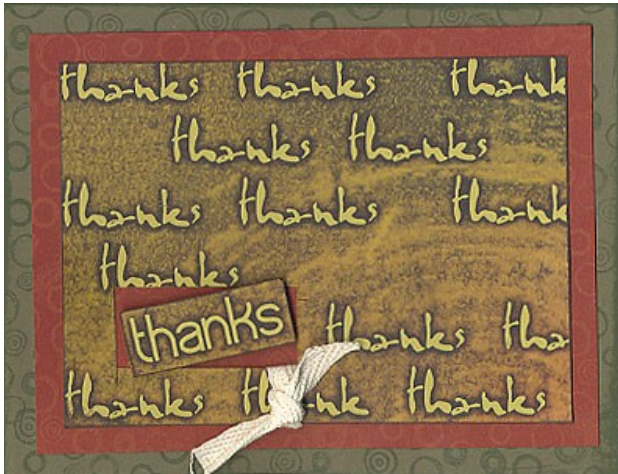


- Green Card with Clay Panel
  - Sand Cutapart: “A Husband . . .”
  - Clay Waxed Linen Thread
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM circle border image onto the Green card with Moss ink.
  2. Punch five equally spaced holes into the right edge of the Clay panel. Stitch with waxed linen thread and tie ends into a small bow.
  3. Nest the cutapart onto the panel and card, aligning on the left edge.



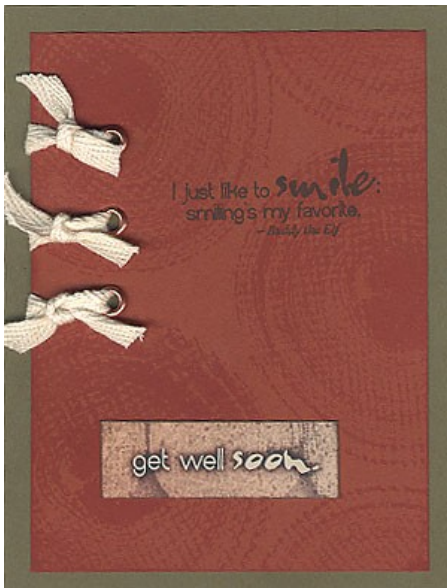


**Card #3**



- Green Card with Clay Panel
  - Celery Cutapart: "Thanks"
  - Twill
  - UM Art Nouveau
1. Stamp the UM reversed circle pattern image onto the Clay panel with Ruby ink. Stamp the UM circle pattern onto the Green card with Moss ink.
  2. Cut the non-cursive "thanks" from the cutapart with a craft knife and cutting mat. Make the rectangular opening slightly larger.
  3. Tie a small piece of twill around the frame and nest the cutapart onto the Clay panel. Attach the "thanks" to the card with foam adhesive and attach the panel onto the card.

**Card #4**



- Green Card with Clay Panel
  - Sand Cutapart: "Get Well Soon"
  - UM Art Nouveau
  - Club Scrap UM Stamps
  - (3) Copper Eyelets
  - Twill
1. Stamp the large UM circle image onto the Clay panel with Ruby ink.
  2. Set three eyelets onto the left edge of the panel and tie a twill ribbon around the edge.
  3. Stamp the UM greeting onto the panel, and attach the Sand cutapart to the lower left corner. Nest the panel onto the card.

**Card #5**



- Green Card with Clay Panel
  - Celery Cutapart: "Just Because" and "You're So Sweet!"
  - Club Scrap UM Stamps
1. Stamp the UM circle trio onto the Green card with Moss ink.
  2. Stamp the same UM circle trio onto the lower edge of the Clay panel with India Black ink. Color the border with watercolor pencils. Use a craft knife to remove the bottom edge of the panel. Layer the panel onto the card.
  3. Trim the "Just Because" cutapart to a smaller size and round the corners. Layer onto the upper right corner of the card with foam adhesive.
  4. Trim the "You're So Sweet!" cutapart into individual words and attach to the panel.
