



**Step Six**  
Fold the mechanism in half at the last score line and place with score lines facing up. Apply adhesive to the 2½x2½ area and all ¾" scored areas of the mechanism. Center one 3x3 Moss Page to the 2½x2½" glued area with the edge of the page right next to the first score line.




**Step Seven**  
Attach the remaining 3x3 Moss Pages to the remaining score lines, taking care not to overlap onto the score line itself.




**Step Eight**  
Temporarily place the Mechanism and Anchor Strip onto the 12x12 page, sandwiching it between that and the folded Mechanism. Make adjustments so that the pages are centered across the top of the layout and the edge of the first Moss page is aligned with the edge of the anchor strip.



**Step Nine**  
Apply adhesive to the back edge of the 3x3 Moss Page, and attach to the Anchor Strip only.



**Step Ten**  
Flip over the Mechanism and anchor strip. Apply adhesive to the entire Anchor Strip only. Attach to the page.



**Step Eleven**  
Test the mechanism by pulling on the Gold tab that extends beyond the edge of the Anchor Strip. It's time to decorate!

Waterfall Page and Card Kit; Scor-It Board or Ruler; Strong Adhesive; Bone Folder


## 5x7 Cascading Waterfall

### Supplies

7x10 Lilac Card; 4¾x6¾ Gold Panel;  
1¾x9 Teal Mechanism; 1x6¾ Moss Anchor Strip;  
(5) 2x2 Teal Waterfall Pages; A7 Envelope


### Step One

Locate and identify the correct pieces for the card, as listed. Score the 7x10 Lilac Card horizontally at 5", and fold to make a 5x7 card. Nest the 4¾x6¾ Gold Panel onto the card and set aside.



### Step Two

Score the 1¾x9 Teal Mechanism at 1¾, 2¼, 2¾, 3¼ and 3¾". Also score the mechanism ½" on the other end to make a small pull tab.



### Step Three

Apply adhesive to the 1¾x1¾" area of the mechanism, and apply a strip of adhesive within each ½" scored area.

### Step Four

Attach one 2x2 Teal Page to the  $1\frac{3}{4} \times 1\frac{3}{4}$ " area of the mechanism, centering onto the strip and aligning the edge of the page with the edge of the first score line. **Note:** Do not overlap onto the score line. Layer the remaining four 2x2" pages to the  $\frac{1}{2}$ " scored areas, aligning with the first page and being careful not to overlap onto the score lines.




### Step Five

Fold the mechanism in half on the last page's score line so that the attached pages are on the top. Fold on the last  $\frac{1}{2}$ " score line and secure with glue to create a reinforced pull tab.




### Step Six

Temporarily place the Mechanism onto the card with the  $1 \times 6\frac{3}{4}$ " Moss Anchor strip sandwiched between the folded Mechanism, as shown. Align the bottom edge of the first 2x2 Teal page with the bottom edge of the Moss Anchor Strip. Make positioning adjustments so that the Mechanism fits onto the Panel.




### Step Seven

Flip the pages up while holding the mechanism and anchor strip in place. Apply adhesive to the back edge of the first 2x2 Teal Page only and place back down onto the Anchor Strip to attach.








### Step Eight

Flip over the entire anchor strip and mechanism. Apply adhesive to the exposed areas of the anchor strip only. Place back onto the card in the planned location.



### Step Nine

Pull on the tab to make the 2x2 pages flip up. Decorate as you wish.



## Supplies

12x12 Lilac Page;  $4\frac{1}{4} \times 6\frac{1}{4}$ " Moss Photo Matte;  $4\frac{3}{4} \times 6\frac{3}{4}$ " Gold Photo Matte; 5x7 Teal Photo Matte;  $1\frac{3}{4} \times 12$ " Teal Decorative Strip; 2x12 Gold Anchor Strip;  $1\frac{1}{4} \times 12$ " Teal Anchor Strip;  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 12$ " Gold Mechanism;  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 9$ " Mechanism Extension; (8) 3x3 Waterfall Pages

### Step One

Carefully locate and identify all pieces as listed. Adhere the  $1\frac{3}{4} \times 12$ " Teal Decorative Strip across the 12x12 Lilac Page, about  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " from the bottom edge.



### Step Two

Nest the Moss, Gold and Teal Photo Mattes and layer onto the left side of the Teal Decorative Strip, as shown.

### Step Three

Adhere the  $1\frac{1}{4} \times 12$ " Teal Anchor Strip onto the 2x12 Gold Anchor Strip; set the strip and page aside.

### Step Four

Starting at  $2\frac{1}{2}$ ", make eight consecutive score lines onto the  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 12$ " Gold Mechanism,  $\frac{3}{4}$ " apart.

### Step Five

Apply adhesive to the  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 2\frac{1}{2}$ " area of the scored mechanism and attach the  $2\frac{1}{2} \times 9$ " Gold Mechanism Extension to the glued area, aligning the edge with the last score line, extending the mechanism.
