## March 2015 Club Scrap® Lite 50s Kitchen

### Materials:

- 50s Kitchen CS® Lite Kit

### Tools and Supplies:

- 12" Paper Trimmer
- Adhesive
- Foam Adhesive
- Glue Dots
- Tape
- 3x14" CS® Grid Ruler
- Scissors

### Measurement Conversions:

- .125 =  $\frac{1}{8}$ "
- .25 =  $\frac{1}{4}$ "
- .375 =  $\frac{3}{8}$ "
- .5 =  $\frac{1}{2}$ "
- .625 =  $\frac{5}{8}$ "
- .75 =  $\frac{3}{4}$ "
- .875 =  $\frac{7}{8}$ "

LB = Left Base Page  
RB = Right Base Page

### Preparation:

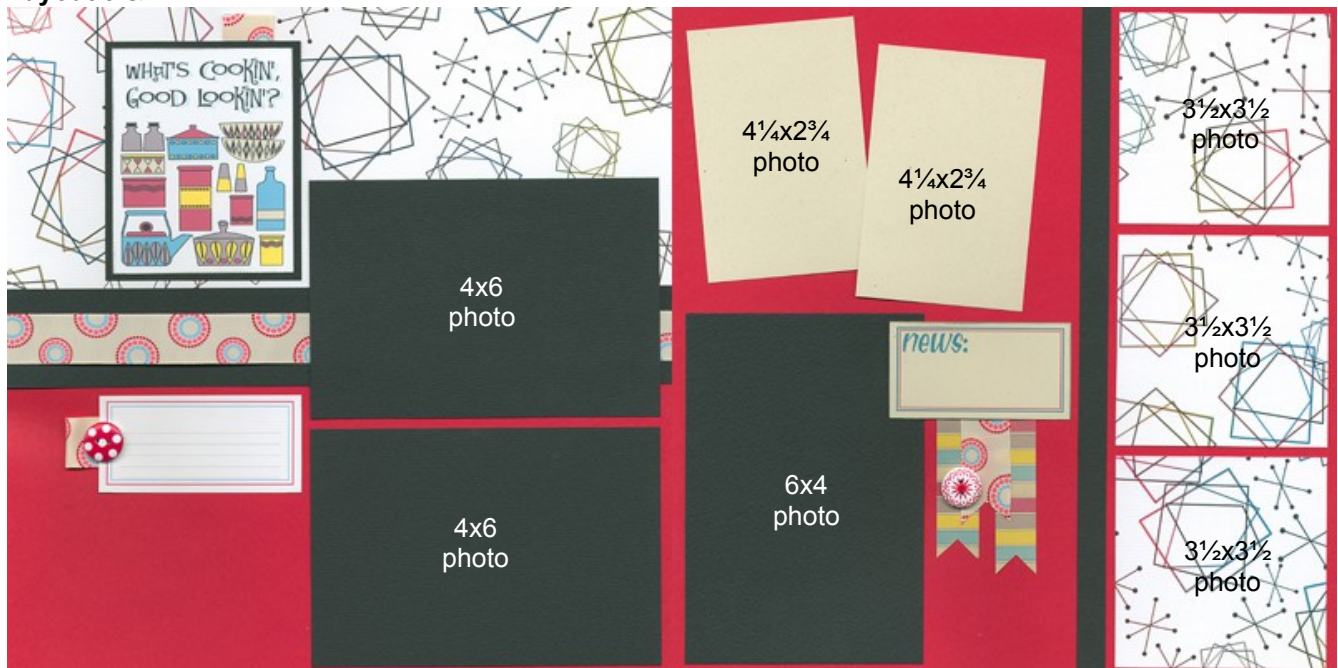
Trim the White and Tan Printed Cutaparts into sections as indicated by the artwork. Some White cutaparts will be used to embellish the mini book included in the Lite kit.

*\*If you do not have an item to complete the layout as shown, simply omit or substitute the item.*





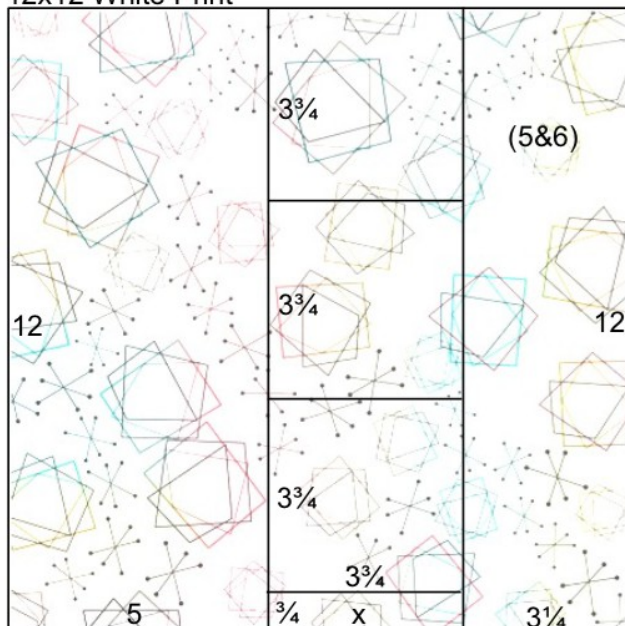
Layout 3 & 4



- (2) 12x12 Red Plains (LB & RB)
- 12x12 White Print
- (2) 3x4.5 Tan Plains (From 1&2)
- 3.5x4.25 Black Plain (From 1&2)
- 1.75x12 Black Plain (From 1&2)
- .5x12 Black Plain (From 1&2)
- (3) 4.25x6.25 Black Photo Mattes
- White Cutaparts
- Tan Cutapart
- Tan Printed Ribbon
- (2) Painted Wood Buttons

1. Cut the 12x12 White Print at 8.75 and 5". Trim the 3.75x12 horizontally at 11.25, 7.5 and 3.75".

## Layout 5 & 6



- 12x12 Tan Plain (LB)
  - 12x12 White Print (RB)
  - (4) 2.75x3.5 Tan Plains (From 1&2)
  - (2) 3.5x4.25 Black Plains (From 1&2)
  - (2) .75x4.25 Black Plains (From 1&2)
  - 1x12 Black Plain (From 1&2)
  - 3.25x12 White Print (From 3&4)
  - (3) 4.25x6.25 Red Photo Mattes
  - White Cutaparts
  - Tan Cutaparts
  - Wood Painted Button
  - Tan Printed Ribbon
1. Lucky you! No paper trimmer needed.



## Layout 7 & 8



- 12x12 Tan Print (LB)
  - 12x12 Black Plain (RB)
  - (2) 3.5x4.25 Tan Prints (From 1&2)
  - (2) 4x6 Tan Plains (From 1&2)
  - 3x4.5 Tan Plain (From 1&2)
  - 1x12 Black Plain (From 1&2)
  - .5x12 Black Plain (From 1&2)
  - (3) 4.25x6.25 Aqua Photo Mattes
  - Tan Cutaparts
  - White Cutaparts
  - Wood Painted Button
1. No trimming needed.
