# Tools:

Bone Folder	1/16" Hole Punch
Trimmer	1/8" Hole Punch
Adhesive	Glue Dots
Tape	Stylus Tool with Blender Tip
Dimensional Adhesive (Foam	Black Marker
Tape)	Pencil
Craft Knife and Cutting Mat	Sticky Notes
Black Ink	CS® Grid Ruler
Versafine Olympia Green Ink	Decorative Corner Punch
(4) Copper Eyelets	

Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making crease, check to make sure that all edges are aligned.

The edges of most cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with black or green ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a more bold effect, sponge directly from the pad onto the card.

# Set A: 3-3/8x4-7/8 New Black Cards with 3-1/8x4-5/8 Berry Panels

#### Card #1



- New Black Card with Berry Panel
- □ CS® WM Oval Frame Stamp
- ☐ Dark Green Die Cut: "Together Forever"
- □ Pink Satin Ribbon
- □ Black Ink
- 1. Stamp the frame image at an angle onto the center of the horizontal Berry panel with black ink. Stamp additional frames around the center frame to cover the panel.
- 2. Carefully remove the center of the oval frame with a craft knife and cutting mat. Be sure to use a sharp blade; turn the paper while cutting to keep the craft knife at a comfortable angle. Ink the edges of the inside of the frame to hide cutting imperfections.
- 3. Layer the frame opening over the Dark Green die cut. Attach the panel to the folded card.

- ☐ Light Green Cutout: "Another Year Better"
- □ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ 1/16" Hole Punch
- □ Black Ink
- □ Olympia Green Ink
- 1. Stamp a row of the UM swirl image along the right edge of the Berry panel with black ink.
- 2. Punch holes into the small circles of the swirl image with the punch.
- 3. Ink the edges of the Light Green cutout with green ink and attach to the panel next to the swirls. Layer the panel onto the card.




- □ New Black Card with Berry Panel
- □ Dark Green Die Cut: "Welcome"
- ☐ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ Green Fiber
- □ Black Ink
- □ Pink Miniature Brad
- Stamp the UM border frame along the bottom edge of the Berry vertical panel with black ink. (Add a hand-written family name when you mail the card.)
- 2. Thread the green fiber onto the top two holes of the Dark Green die cut. Tie a knot and attach to the card with a brad.
- 3. Layer the die cut onto the panel with dimensional adhesive. Attach the panel to the card.




- □ New Black Card with Berry Panel
- □ 3-3/8x8-3/8 Light Green Panel (From Set C)
- □ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ WM Nameplate Stamp
- ☐ Light Green Cutout: "Save the Date"
- □ Black Ink
- □ Black Marker
- Stamp the nameplate image at the bottom of the vertical Berry panel with black ink.
   Remove the center of the name plate with a craft knife and cutting mat.
- 2. Stamp the UM corner swirl onto the upper left corner of the panel with black ink.
- 3. Stamp the UM word "tradition" onto the Light Green panel with black ink. Trim the word from the panel and attach behind the opening in the Berry panel.
- 4. Circle the date and write in the month on the Light Green cutout; attach to the upper center of the panel. Layer the panel onto the card.






- □ New Black Card
- ☐ Berry Cutout: "Friends are Like Flowers"
- ☐ Light Green Cutout: "Friends are Like Flowers"
- □ Pink Satin Ribbon
- □ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ Black Ink
- Cut a window into the Berry cutout with a craft knife and cutting mat. Ink
  the inside edges of the window. Trim closely around the outside perimeter
  of the cutout so that it is smaller than the Light Green cutout.
- 2. Attach the Berry cutout to the corresponding Light Green cutout with dimensional adhesive.
- 3. Wrap the pink satin ribbon around the upper left and lower right corners of the cutouts. Secure ribbon ends onto the back with tape. Attach the cutouts to the upper left corner of the horizontal New Black card.
- 4. Stamp the UM corner swirl image into the lower right corner of the card with black ink.

# Set B: 4-3/8x6-1/2 Berry Cards with 4-1/8x6-1/4 Dark Green Panels



- □ Berry Card with Dark Green Panel
- ☐ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ CS® WM Oval Frame Stamp
- □ Olympia Green Ink
- ☐ CS® Grid Ruler and Pencil
- ☐ Sticky Notes (for masking)
- 1. Stamp the UM "To Live, to Love..." image onto the upper right center of the Dark Green panel with green ink. Draw a rectangle around the image with a pencil and ruler.
- 2. Draw additional rectangles onto the panel with a ruler and pencil to divide it into sections.
- 3. Mask one entire section of the panel at a time with several sticky notes. Stamp images into the sections and sponge around the edges with green ink. (For more contrast, use alternating colors of ink.)
- 4. Layer the completed panel onto the Berry card.






- Berry Card with Dark Green Panel
- 3-3/8x8-3/8 Light Green Panel (Remaining from Set A, Card #4)
- ☐ 3-1/8x4-5/8 Berry Panel
- □ CS® WM Oval Frame Stamp
- □ Dark Green Die Cut: "You Did It!"
- □ Berry Cutout: "Heard the Great News"
- □ Black Ink
- Stamp the oval frame onto the Berry panel with black ink. Carefully remove the center oval with a craft knife and cutting mat. Ink the inside edge of the frame to disguise cutting imperfections. Trim the frame to 3x3".
- 2. Layer the frame opening over the Dark Green die cut. Trim the Light Green Panel to 3-3/8x3-3/8". Layer beneath the Berry frame.
- 3. Attach the Berry frame and the Berry cutout to the Dark Green panel; layer the panel onto the card.



- Berry Card with Dark Green Panel
- □ Berry Cutout: "Happy Belated"□ Light Green Cutout: "Happy
  - Belated"

- 1. Trim the flourish from the Light Green cutout. Ink the edges and layer over the flourish on the Berry cutout with dimensional adhesive (foam tape).
- 2. Attach the cutouts to the lower right corner of the Dark Green panel; layer the panel onto the card.



- **Berry Card**
- Dark Green Die Cut: "Sending Happy Thoughts"
- WM Stamp: "The Meaning of Life..."
- □ (2) Black Eyelets
- Decorative Corner Punch.
  - Black Ink
- 1. Stamp the WM image onto the upper center of a vertical Berry card with black ink.
- 2. Remove the inside square from the Dark Green die cut with a craft knife and cutting mat. Set two eyelets into the top two holes of the die cut.
- 3. Trim the lower left and right corners of the die cut with a decorative corner punch.
- 4. Center the die cut opening over the stamped quote on the Berry card and attach with dimensional adhesive.



- Berry Card with Dark Green PanelUM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ WM "Happy Anniversary" Stamp□ CS® WM Oval Frame Stamp
- Olympia Green Ink

- 1. Stamp "Happy Anniversary" across the bottom edge of the horizontal Dark Green panel with green ink.
- 2. Stamp the oval frame twice onto the upper half of the panel with green ink. Stamp the boy and girl silhouette images into the oval frames with green ink.
- 3. Layer the Dark Green panel onto the card.




# Set C: 3-5/8x8-5/8 Dark Green Cards with 3-3/8x8-3/8 Light Green Panels

#### Card #1




- 1. Stamp the UM corner swirl into the upper left and lower right corner of a horizontal Light Green panel with green ink. Trim the opposite corners with a decorative corner punch.
- 2. Set copper eyelets into all four corners of the Dark Green die cut. Attach to the center of the panel; layer the panel onto the card.




- □ Dark Green Card with Light Green Panel
- □ Berry Cutout: "So Happy for You"
- □ UM Borders & Backgrounds
- □ (2) Pink Miniature Brads
- □ Olympia Green Ink
- ☐ Sticky Notes (for masking)
- 1. Attach the Berry die cut to the upper center of the vertical Light Green panel.
- 2. Mask the area just above the cutout with a sticky note. Sponge ink over the edge of the mask and stamp the area with the word collage and green ink. Mask the area below the Berry cutout, and repeat the sponging and stamping.
- 3. Attach a pink mini brad on either side of the cutout and layer the panel onto the card.



- Dark Green Card with Light Green Panel
- Dark Green Die Cut: "You're a Friend"
- □ Pink Satin Ribbon
- □ Olympia Green Ink
- 1. Slide the green inkpad directly over the entire surface of the Light Green panel so that the texture of the paper is revealed.
- 2. Cut a slit on each side of the "You're a Friend" quote on the Dark Green die cut with a craft knife and cutting mat. Slide the pink ribbon through the slits and attach the die cut to the Light Green panel. Wrap the ribbon ends around to the back side of the panel and secure with tape.
- 3. Attach the panel to the card.



- □ Dark Green Card with Light Green Panel
- ☐ Berry Cutout: "Breathe..."
- □ Pink Satin Ribbon
- □ Pink Miniature Brad
- 1. Trim the Light Green panel vertically at 2". Layer onto the center of the card.
- Punch a 1/8" hole into the top two corners of the Berry cutout. Thread the ribbon through the holes, and make a loop at the top. Secure the loop with a pink mini brad. Tape the ribbon ends to the back of the cutout.
- 3. Attach the cutout to the upper center of the vertical card with dimensional adhesive.



- Stamp the UM border frame onto the right side of the horizontal Light Green strip with black ink. Remove the center of the frame with a craft knife and cutting mat.
- 2. Ink only the word "Memories" on the UM "Treasured Memories" image with black ink. Stamp onto a Berry cutout or scrap.
- 3. Layer the stamped "Memories" image behind the window on the Light Green panel.
- 4. Stamp the bottom edge of the horizontal Dark Green card with the UM flourish image and black ink.
- 5. Layer the Light Green strip onto the card.
