- Welcome Family Stickers (CS Kit Goodie)

### Measurement Conversions:

.25 =  $\frac{1}{4}$ "  
.5 =  $\frac{1}{2}$ "  
.75 =  $\frac{3}{4}$ "

*Notes: Trim the Manilla cutaparts into sections as indicated by the artwork. Remove the Aqua Print die cuts from the parent sheet. Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned.*

*If you do not have an item required to complete a card, simply omit the step or substitute the item.*



**Set A: 5x8" Salmon Cards with 5½x8½" Gray Panels**

**Card #1**



- Salmon Card with Gray Panel
  - Manilla Cutpart: "Congratulations"
  - UM FontArt
  - Family Stickers
  - Sheer Ribbon
1. Wrap ribbon around the cutpart and layer onto the Salmon card with foam adhesive. Attach the sticker to the lower right corner of the cutpart.
  2. Stamp the alphabet border above and below the cutpart with black ink. Layer the card onto the panel.

**Card #2**



- Salmon Card with Gray Panel
  - Manilla Cutpart: "Wishing You the Happiest. . ."
  - Family Stickers
1. Using a craft knife, ruler and cutting mat, cut the frame from the cutpart. Layer the frame at an angle onto the Salmon card and add the inner part of the frame to the center with foam adhesive.
  2. Center the card onto the Gray panel. Finish with the "love" sticker.

**Card #3**



- Salmon Card with Gray Panel
  - Aqua Die Cut: "Get Well Soon"
  - (3) Paper Flowers
  - (4) Pronged Ornaments
1. Set the pronged ornaments into the four corners of the Aqua die cut. Layer onto the Salmon card with foam adhesive.
  2. Attach three paper flowers beneath the die cut and center the card onto the panel.

**Card #4**



- Salmon Card with Gray Panel
  - Aqua Die Cut: "Happy Anniversary"
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - WM "Welcome Home" Stamp
  - Family Stickers
  - (4) Mini Brads
1. Stamp the WM and UM images onto the Salmon card with Ruby ink.
  2. Set a brad into each corner of the die cut and attach to the card with foam adhesive. Add the heart sticker.
  3. Layer the card onto the Gray panel.

**Card #5**



- Salmon Card with Gray Panel
  - Manilla Cutapart: "Relax. . ."
  - (4) Paper Flowers
1. Nest the cutapart onto the Salmon card and Gray panel.
  2. Add a paper flower to each corner of the cutapart.

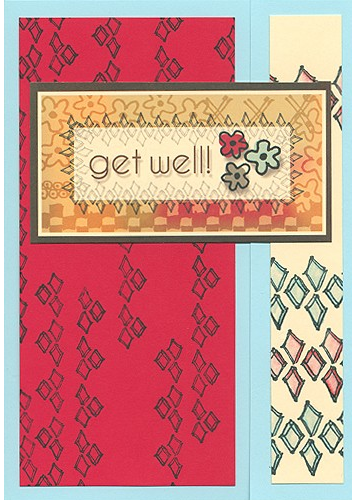
**Set B: 5x7" Aqua Cards with 1x6½" Manilla and 3x6½" Red Panels**

**Card #1**



- Aqua Card with Manilla and Red Panels
  - Aqua Die Cuts: "Happy," "Happy," and "Birthday"
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Waxed Linen Thread
1. Stamp the Red and Manilla panels with the UM image and black ink. Color the flowers on the Manilla panels with watercolor pencils.
  2. Tie waxed linen thread onto each pre-punched corner of the Aqua die cuts. Attach to the Red panel with foam adhesive.
  3. Wrap thread around the Manilla panel several times and secure with a double knot. Trim thread tails. Nest the panels onto the card flaps.

### Card #2



- Aqua Card with Manilla and Red Panels
  - Manilla Cutaparts: "Get Well!"
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the Red and Manilla panels with the UM images. Color the stamped images on the Manilla panel with watercolor pencils. Nest the panels onto the card.
  2. Attach the Manilla cutapart to the Red panel on the card. (Use caution when applying adhesive.)

### Card #3



- Aqua Card with Manilla and Red Panels
  - Aqua Die Cuts
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Waxed Linen Thread
  - (8) Large Eyelets
1. Stamp the UM "cat in window" image onto the Red panel with Ruby ink. Attach the panel to the large flap of the Aqua card. Attach the Manilla panel to the small flap of the card.
  2. Set an eyelet into the corners of each die cut. Tie waxed linen thread through the top two eyelets. Attach the die cuts to the left flap with foam adhesive.

### Card #4



- Aqua Card with Manilla and Red Panels
  - Blue Die Cut: "Congratulations"
  - (2) Mini Brads
  - Family Stickers
  - Paper Flower
1. Nest the Manilla and Red panels onto the card flaps.
  2. Set two brads into the holes on the right side of the die cut. Attach a flower on the left edge and layer onto the Manilla panel.
  3. Place the sticker on the Red panel.

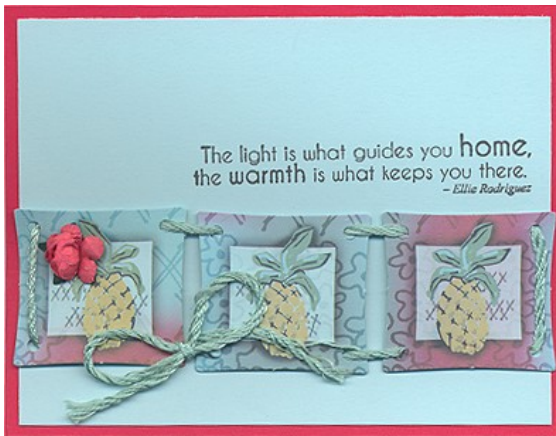
**Card #5**



- Aqua Card with Manilla and Red Panels
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Sheer Ribbon
  - Paper Flower
  - Family Stickers
1. Tie ribbon around the left edge of the Red panel. Add a paper flower near the ribbon tie. Stamp the UM greeting on the right edge of the panel with black ink. Layer the panel onto the card.
  2. Adhere the border sticker to the Manilla panel and attach to the card.

**Set C: 4 1/4 x 5 1/2" Red Cards with 4 x 5 1/4" Aqua Panels**

**Card #1**



- Red Card with Aqua Panel
  - (3) Aqua Die Cuts: Pineapples
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Aqua Fiber
  - Paper Flower
1. Thread the fiber through the die cuts to link together and tie with a bow. Attach the die cuts to the Aqua panel with foam adhesive.
  2. Stamp the UM greeting above the die cuts with black ink. Finish with a paper flower.

**Card #2**



- Red Card with Aqua Panel
  - Manilla Cutpart: "Thanks"
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - WM "Big Hugs for You" Stamp
1. Using a craft knife, ruler and cutting mat, cut the center of the frame from the cutpart. (Attach the "thanks" portion of the cutpart to the inside of the card.)
  2. Mark a frame onto the Aqua panel 1.25" from each edge. Cut diagonally from corner to corner within the marked frame to make an "x." Tear away the four paper flaps to create a torn frame.
  3. Layer the Aqua panel and Manilla frame onto the Red card. Stamp the UM and WM images into the frame with black ink.



**Card #3**



- Red Card with Aqua Panel
  - WM “Welcome Home” Stamp
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Family Sticker
1. Mist WM stamp with water and color with watercolor crayons or gelatos. Mist lightly and stamp onto the Aqua panel.
  2. Stamp the UM quote beneath the image and layer onto the Red card. Attach the heart sticker to the door.

**Card #4**



- Red Card with Aqua Panel
  - Manilla Cutapart: “Happy Birthday”
  - Sheer Ribbon
  - WM “Xtraordinary” Stamp
1. Stamp the Aqua panel with the WM image and black ink. For best results, stamp at an angle while staggering the rows. Attach the panel to the card.
  2. Distress the outer edge of the cutapart with a paper distressing tool. Tie sheer ribbon around the left edge and layer onto the panel with foam adhesive.

**Card #5**



- Red Card with Aqua Panel
  - Manilla Cutapart: “You're the Best!”
  - Aqua Fiber
1. Using a ruler, craft knife and cutting mat, cut the frame from the cutapart. Tie fiber around the right edge of the frame and layer onto the Aqua panel.
  2. Attach the center of the frame at an angle onto the panel with foam adhesive. Center the panel onto the card.
