- Henna Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds
- Henna CS® Wood Mounted “Montage” Stamp
- Henna Wood Mounted “Thinking of You” Stamp
- Henna Wood Mounted “Isn’t Life Beautiful?” Stamp
- Henna Flourish Stencil

Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

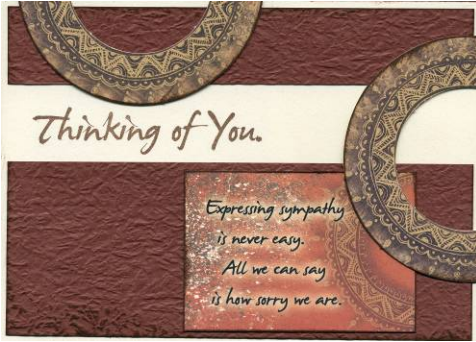
Prepare the Cutapart sheets by trimming along the fine cutting guidelines.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 4-1/2 x 6-1/4 Eggshell Cards with Chocolate Panels

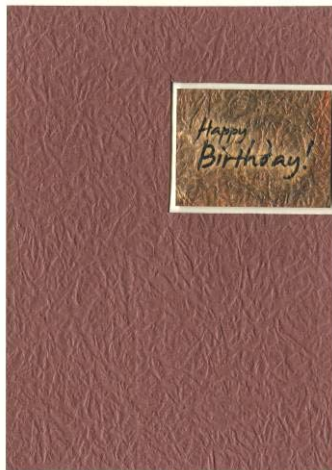
Card #1



- Eggshell Card with Chocolate Panel
- WM "Thinking of You" Stamp
- Eggshell Cutpart: "Expressing Sympathy..."
- Eggshell Circular Die Cut: Patterned Circle

1. Remove a 1.25" strip from the middle of the Chocolate panel and attach to the card as shown.
2. Stamp "Thinking of You" into the open gap.
3. Layer the sympathy cutpart within the bottom section. Cut the circular die cut and attach to the edges of the card.

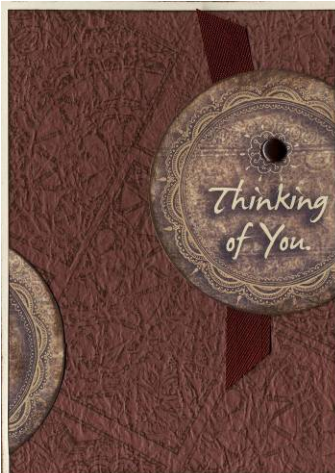
Card #2



- Eggshell Card with Chocolate Panel
- Tan Cutpart: "Happy Birthday!"

1. Temporarily place the cutpart onto the upper right edge of the Chocolate panel. Trace around the three sides of the cutpart.
2. Trim an area 1/8" larger than the traced rectangle with a grid ruler and craft knife.
3. Attach the cutpart directly onto the card with double-sided foam adhesive.

Card #3



- Eggshell Card with Chocolate Panel
- 5/8" Brown Ribbon
- Large Antique Brass Brad
- Eggshell Circular Die Cut: "Thinking of You"
- CS® WM Montage Stamp

1. Stamp a pattern onto the Chocolate panel with the WM stamp and Earth ink.
2. Attach a length of brown ribbon to the back of the circular die cut and attach to the right edge of the Chocolate panel with a brad.
3. Trim the excess die cut and attach to the lower left corner of the panel. Layer the panel onto the card.

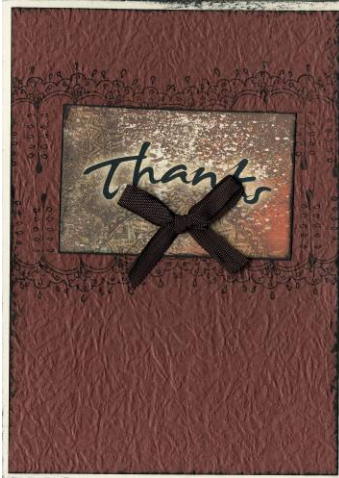


Card #4



- Eggshell Card with Chocolate Panel
 - Eggshell Circular Die Cuts: Decorative Ring and "Thank You"
 - Narrow Brown Ribbon
1. Rub Earth ink directly onto the textured Chocolate panel to highlight the raised surface.
 2. Tie three short lengths of brown rayon ribbon to the die cut ring and attach to the panel. Add the "Thank you" die cut, as shown. Layer the panel onto the card.

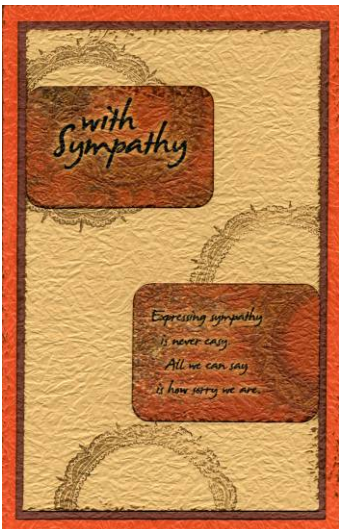
Card #5



- Eggshell Card with Chocolate Panel
 - Eggshell Cutapart: "Thanks"
 - Narrow Brown Ribbon
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM border twice across the top portion of the vertical Chocolate panel with Onyx ink.
 2. Tie the ribbon into a small bow and attach to the cutpart. Layer within the stamped area.

Set B: 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 Burnt Orange Cards with Chocolate and Tan Panels

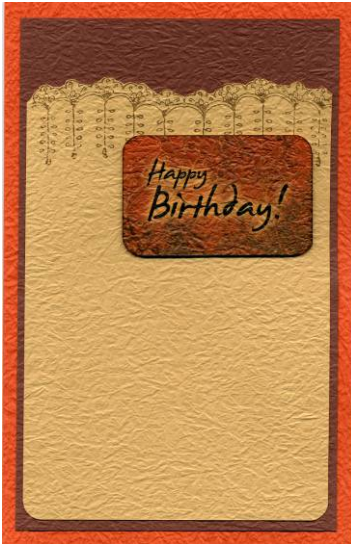
Card #1



- Burnt Orange Card with Chocolate and Tan Panels
 - Tan Cutaparts: "With Sympathy" and "Expressing Sympathy..."
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Using Earth ink, stamp the circular UM image three times onto the Tan panel, being sure to go off the edges.
 2. Round the corners of the two cutaparts and attach to the edges of the Tan panel. Nest onto the Chocolate panel and Burnt Orange card.



Card #2



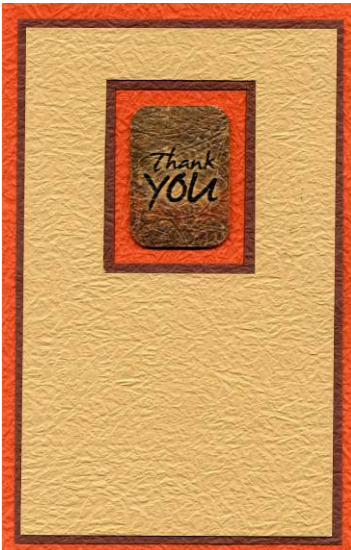
- Burnt Orange Card with Chocolate and Tan Panels
 - Tan Cutpart: "Happy Birthday"
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM border onto the top of the vertical Tan panel with Onyx ink. Carefully cut along the edge of the stamped image to create a decorative edge. Layer onto the Chocolate panel and Burnt Orange Card
 2. Round the corners of the cutpart and attach beneath the border.

Card #3



- Burnt Orange Card with Chocolate and Tan Panels
 - 3-1/2 x 8-1/2 Burnt Orange Panel (Set C)
 - Eggshell Circular Die Cuts: "Celebrate Everything" and Decorative Circle
 - Eggshell Cutpart: "Happy Birthday!"
1. Trim the 3-1/2x8-1/2 Burnt Orange panel vertically at 1.5". Cut the 1.5x8.5 strip horizontally at 7.75".
 2. Thread the Burnt Orange strip through the circular die cut and attach to the Tan panel. Layer the decorative circle as shown. Attach the cutpart to the panel, layer onto the Chocolate panel and Burnt Orange card.

Card #4



- Burnt Orange Card with Chocolate and Tan Panels
 - Tan Cutpart: "Thank You"
1. Center the Tan cutpart onto the upper half of the Tan panel and trace around the perimeter. With a grid ruler and craft knife, cut a rectangle into the panel 3/8" larger than the traced box.
 2. Center the Tan panel onto the Chocolate panel and trace the window onto the Chocolate panel. Cut a window 1/8" smaller than the traced shape. Adhere the panels onto the card.
 3. Round the corners of the cutpart and attach to the center of the nested windows with foam adhesive.



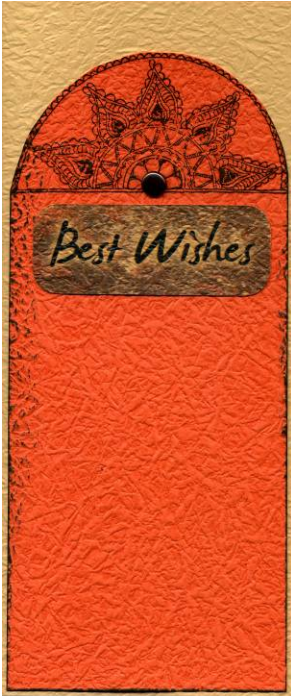
Card #5



- Burnt Orange Card with Chocolate and Tan Panels
 - Eggshell Circular Die Cut: "Happy Anniversary"
 - Narrow Brown Ribbon
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM heart image across a horizontal Tan panel with Earth ink. Cut along the top of the stamped border to create a decorative edge.
 2. Attach the circular die cut and ribbon to the Tan panel. Round the corners of the Chocolate panel and layer both panels onto the card.

Set C: 3-3/4 x 8-3/4 Tan Cards with Burnt Orange Panels

Card #1



- Tan Card with Burnt Orange Panel
 - Tan Cutapart: "Best Wishes"
 - Antique Brass Brad
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM half circle image onto the upper half of the vertical Burnt Orange panel with Onyx ink.
 2. Cut along the rounded area of the stamped image, insert a brad into the center, and layer the panel onto the card.
 3. Round the corners of the cutapart and attach.

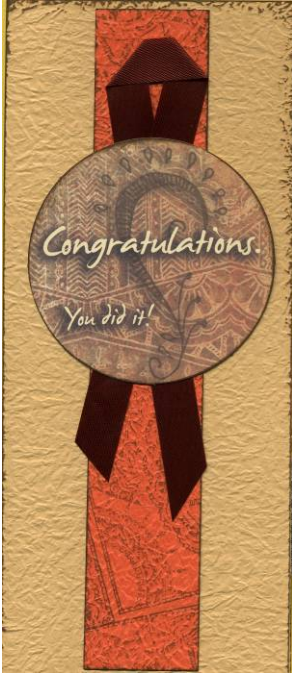
Card #2



- Tan Card with Burnt Orange Panel
 - Eggshell Circular Die Cuts: Large "Happy Birthday" and Small "Happy Birthday"
 - CS Flourish Stencil
1. Decorate the Burnt Orange panel with the stencil and Earth ink.
 2. Cut the large die cut in half and layer onto the card, as shown. Attach the small die cut with foam adhesive.



Card #3



- Tan Card
- Eggshell Circular Die Cut: "Congratulations"
- WM Montage Stamp
- 2x8.5" Burnt Orange (From Set B, Card #3)
- 5/8" Brown Ribbon

1. Stamp a pattern onto the Burnt Orange strip with the WM image and Earth ink. Trim to 1.5" and attach to the center of the card
2. Make a large loop with the brown ribbon and secure behind the circular die cut. Layer onto the card.

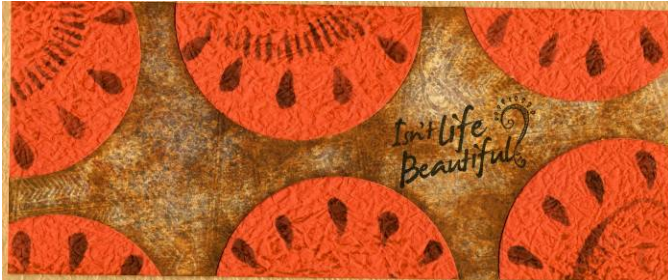
Card #4



- Tan Card with Burnt Orange Panel
- Eggshell Cutapart: "Best Wishes"
- Antique Brass Brad
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Heavily distress the perimeter of the Burnt Orange panel and stamp the border image at right with Onyx ink.
2. Attach the cutapart to the panel with a brad and layer onto the card.

Card #5



- Tan Card with Burnt Orange Panel
- Circular Die Cut: (Remnant)
- WM "Isn't Life Beautiful?" Stamp
- Flourish Stencil

1. Attach the remnant from the circular die cut to the Burnt Orange panel; trim edges to fit. Stencil into the open areas, as desired.
2. Stamp the WM image onto the die cut with Onyx ink.
