May 2011 Greetings to Go Papillon

Materials:

- *Papillon* Greetings to Go
- *Papillon* Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds and FontArt
- *Papillon* Wood Mounted “Wings of Love” Stamp
- *Papillon* Wood Mounted “Flutterby” Stamp

Tools and Supplies:

- 12” Paper Trimmer
- Scissors
- Adhesive
- Foam Adhesive
- Tape
- CS® Grid Ruler
- CS® Bookbinding Glue
- CS® India Black, Moss, Orchid, Sapphire, Amethyst and Topaz Ink
- CS® Ink Applicator
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat
- Paper Piercing Tool and Cork Board
- Needle
- Watercolor Pencils and Waterbrush
- White Plain Paper (POPs work great!)
- Crop-A-Dile
- ¼” Eyelet
- Glitter Glue
- Chalks
- Lavender Mini Brad (*Destinations*, 7/10 Goodie)
- White and Black Photo Mounting Corners (3L)

Measurement Conversions:

.25 = ¼”
.5 = ½”
.75 = ¾”

Notes: Trim the White Cutparts into sections as indicated by the artwork. Remove the Sunshine die cuts from the parent sheet. Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned.

If you do not have an item required to complete a card, simply omit the step or substitute the item.

Set A:
3-7/8x8-7/8" Sunshine Cards with 3-1/4x8-1/2" White Panels

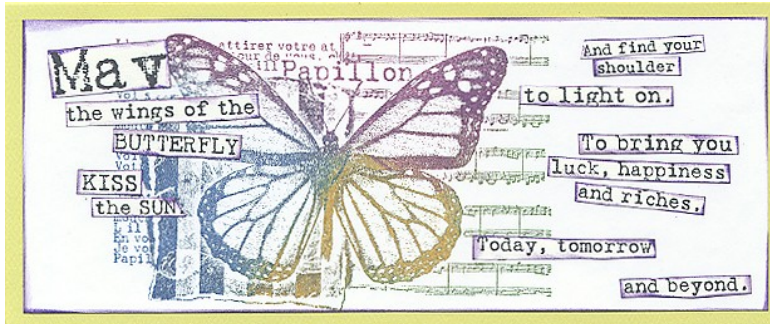
Card #1



- Sunshine Card with White Panel
- White Cutapart: "Wishing You All the Best. . ."

1. Cut the quote from the frame on the cutapart with a ruler and craft knife. Center the cutapart onto the White panel and cut a frame into the panel that is slightly larger than the original. Nest onto the card.
2. Trim the text from the quote removed from cutapart with a scissors. Ink the edges and center within the frame.

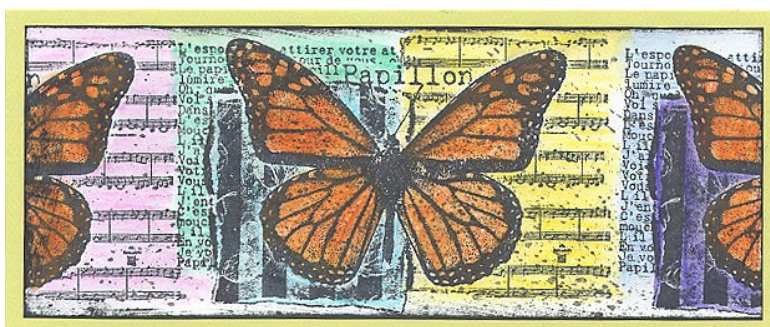
Card #2



- Sunshine Card with White Panel
- WM "Wings of Love" Stamp
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- White Plain Paper

1. Ink the WM stamp with Topaz, Orchid, Sapphire and Moss. Stamp onto the White panel.
2. Stamp the UM quote onto White Plain with black ink. Cut the quote into strips and sections of words. Ink the edges with Amethyst and glue onto the White panel. Nest the panel onto the card.

Card #3



- Sunshine Card with White Panel
- WM "Wings of Love" Stamp

1. Stamp the WM "Wings of Love" stamp three times onto the White panel with black ink, starting at center.
2. Color the stamped images with watercolor pencils and blend with a waterbrush. Splatter with watercolor.

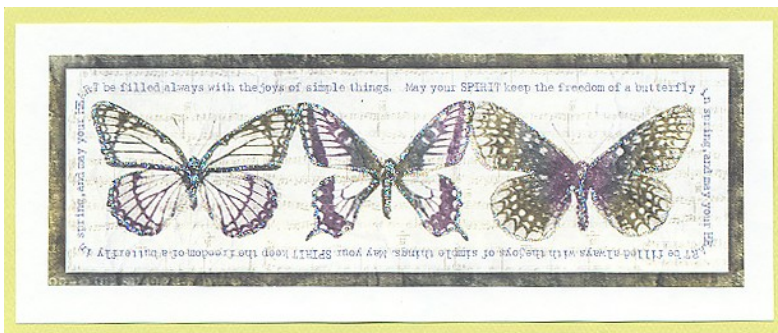


Card #4



- Sunshine Card with White Panel
 - White Cutapart: “Get Well Soon”
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - White Plain Paper
1. Nest the White cutapart onto the White panel and Sunshine card.
 2. Stamp the UM small butterflies image onto White Plain with Amethyst ink. Trim the butterflies from the paper. Bend the wings up and glue the body portions to the panel. (Trust me, this card looks nifty with the butterfly wings!)

Card #5



- Sunshine Card with White Panel
 - White Cutapart: “May Your Spirit. . .”
1. Nest the cutapart onto the White panel and Sunshine card.
 2. Add glitter glue to the perimeter of the butterfly wings.

Set B: 2-3/4x4-1/4” White Z-Fold or Tri-Fold Cards with 2-1/2x4” Violet and 2-1/4x3-3/4” Sunshine Panels

Card #1



- White Card with Violet and Sunshine Panels
 - White Cutaparts: “Congrats!” and “You Deserve It!”
 - Silver Butterfly Bead
 - Lavender Waxed Linen Thread
 - (4) White Photo Mounting Corners
1. Pierce holes into the White “Congratulatory!” cutapart with a paper piercing tool. Stitch the butterfly charm into place with waxed linen.
 2. Nest the cutapart onto the Sunshine and Violet panels with white photo mounting corners and layer onto the card. Attach the “You Deserve It!” cutapart to the inside of the card.



Card #2



- White Card with Violet and Sunshine Panels
 - Sunshine Die Cuts: “Sorry. . . ” and “Can You Reschedule. . . ?”
 - White Organza Ribbon
 - Lavender Waxed Linen Thread
 - Silver Butterfly Bead
 - Lavender Mini Brad
1. Attach the Sunshine die cut to the Violet panel with the lavender brad. Tie the organza ribbon around the panel, creating a knot within the large circular opening on the die cut.
 2. Thread the bead onto the waxed linen thread and tie a knot to hold the bead in place. Tie the thread to the knot in the ribbon so that the bead dangles over the butterfly.
 3. Layer the Violet panel onto the front of the card. Attach the remaining die cut and panel to the inside of the card.

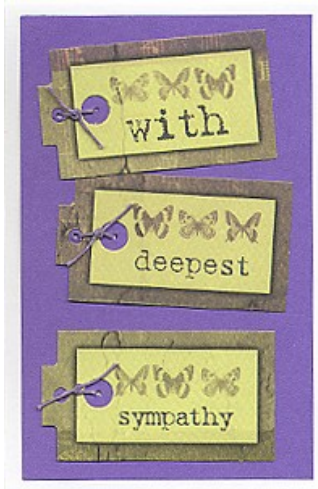
Card #3



- White Card with Violet and Sunshine Panels
- White Cutaparts: “Happy Birthday” and Framed Butterfly
- Sunshine Die Cut: Punched Circle Remnant
- Silver Butterfly Bead
- Lavender Waxed Linen Thread

1. Thread the bead onto the waxed linen and wrap around the cutapart several times. Secure with a knot. Slide the circular die cut beneath the butterfly to highlight. (The butterfly will slide up and down the thread.)
2. Nest the cutapart onto the Violet panel and attach to the card. Nest the remaining cutapart onto the Sunshine panel and attach to the inside of the card.

Card #4



- White Card with Violet and Sunshine Panels
 - Sunshine Die Cuts: “With,” “Deepest,” and “Sympathy”
 - Lavender Waxed Linen Thread
1. Attach the Sunshine die cuts to the Violet panel with adhesive. Pierce a hole through each die cut opening. Thread waxed linen through each pair of pierced holes and tie into a knot.
 2. Layer the Violet panel onto the White card. Attach the Sunshine panel to the inside of the card.

Card #5



- White Card with Violet and Sunshine Panels
 - White Cutaparts: "Thanks!" and "A Million!"
 - White Organza Ribbon
1. Tie the ribbon around the White cutapart and nest onto the Violet panel and White card.
 2. Attach the "a million!" cutapart to the Sunshine panel and layer onto the inside of the card.

Set C:

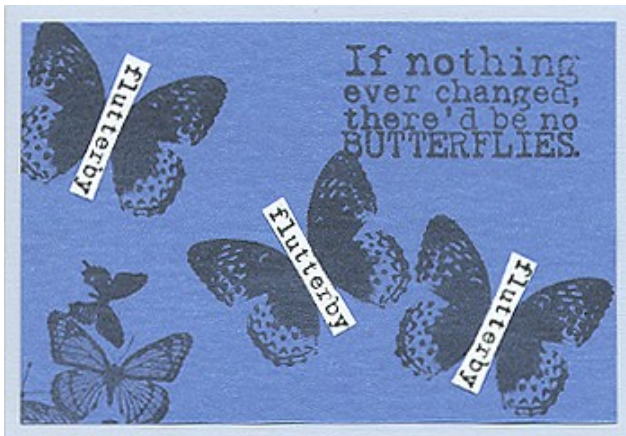
3-3/8x4-7/8" Soft Blue Cards with 3-1/8x4-5/8" Metallic Blue Panels

Card #1



- Soft Blue Card with Metallic Blue Panel
 - White Cutapart: Butterfly
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - White Plain Paper
1. Use a craft knife to cut around the outside edge of the butterfly wings on the cutapart, leaving the body in tact. Nest onto the Metallic Blue panel. Colorize the butterfly with chalks, if desired. Support the butterfly wings with foam adhesive.
 2. Stamp the UM quote onto White Plain with black ink. Trim out each individual line of words.
 3. Glue the word strips to the cutapart with bookbinding glue.

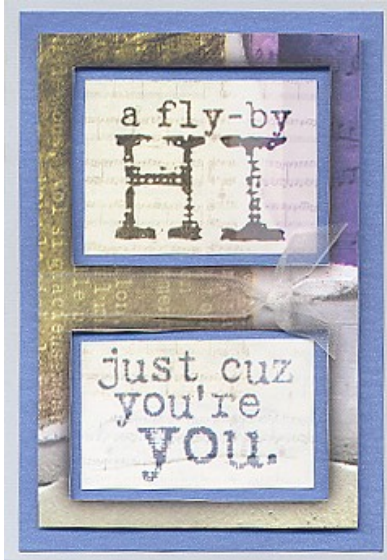
Card #2



- Soft Blue Card with Metallic Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - WM "Flutterby" Stamp
 - White Plain Paper
1. Stamp the UM and WM images onto the Metallic Blue panel with black ink and nest onto the card.
 2. Stamp the WM image three times onto White Plain. Cut out the "flutterby" portion of the stamped image and glue into place over the stamped butterflies on the panel.



Card #3



- Soft Blue Card with Metallic Blue Panel
 - White Cutapart: "A Fly-by Hi"
 - White Organza Ribbon
1. Use a craft knife to cut the printed words from each window of the cutapart. Trim 1/8" from the edges of each tile of text.
 2. Tie ribbon around the remaining portion of the frame and attach to the Metallic Blue panel with foam adhesive. Nest the panel onto the card.
 3. Position the trimmed text panels into the frame openings.

Card #4



- Soft Blue Card with Metallic Blue Panel
 - UM FontArt
 - Black Photo Mounting Corners
1. Stamp the UM FontArt text block onto the Metallic Blue panel with black ink.
 2. Attach the panel to the card with black photo mounting corners.

Card #5



- Soft Blue Card with Metallic Blue Panel
 - White Cutapart: "May Your Anniversary. . ."
 - Sunshine Die Cut: Butterfly
 - 1/4" Eyelet
1. Use a Crop-A-Dile to attach the Sunshine die cut to the White cutapart with an eyelet.
 2. Nest the cutapart onto the Metallic Blue panel and card.
