Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 4-1/4x5-1/2" Asphalt Cards with 3-3/4x5" Light Blue Panels

Card #1



- Asphalt Card with Light Blue Panel
- White Die Cut Tags: "Wow" and "Thanks"
- (2) Silver Brads

1. Adhere the White die cuts onto the Light Blue panel and add the brads to the openings at the top of each tag.
2. Layer the Light Blue panel onto the card.

Card #2



- Asphalt Card with Light Blue Panel
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- WM "Winged Victory" Stamp

1. Trim the Light Blue Panel vertically at 2.5". Cut each strip horizontally at 3".
2. Stamp each Light Blue piece with the UM and WM images, as shown, and arrange onto the folded card with space between each piece.

Card #3



- Asphalt Card with Light Blue Panel
- White Die Cut Tags: "Winged Happy Birthday" Trio
- Light Blue Satin Ribbon

1. Trim the Light Blue Panel horizontally at 2.5".
2. Adhere the three White die cut tags onto the Light Blue panel. Staple the ribbon onto the top of each tag and attach the panel to the card.



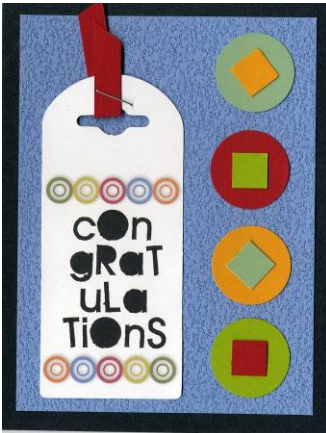
Card #4



- Asphalt Card with Light Blue Panel
- White Die Cut Tag: "You're So Cool"
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Blue Grid Ribbon

1. Stamp the UM crown image across the top edge of the Light Blue panel.
2. Trim the left edge from the White die cut tag, and round the upper right and lower left corners.
3. Tie the ribbon into a bow and attach to the tag. Layer the tag and panel onto the card at an angle.

Card #5



- Asphalt Card with Light Blue Panel
- White Die Cut Tag: "Congratulations"
- Assorted Colorful POP's or Scraps

1. Punch four colorful 1" circles and four ½" squares from colorful paper scraps and assemble onto the right side of the Light Blue Panel, as shown.
2. Staple a red paper strip to the top of the die cut tag and attach to the left side of the panel; layer the panel onto the card.

Set B: 4x9-1/4" Dark Blue Cards with 3-3/4x9" White Panels

Card #1



- Dark Blue Card with White Panel
- WM "Winged Victory" Stamp
- Light Blue Perforated Tag: "Birthday Candles by the Case"
- Light Blue Satin Ribbon

1. Stamp the WM image onto the White panel three times with dark blue ink. Stamp additional times onto the background with pale blue ink.
2. Tie ribbon onto the left and right edges of the tag top. Attach the tag with foam tape, bring ribbon ends around to the back, and layer the panel onto the card.

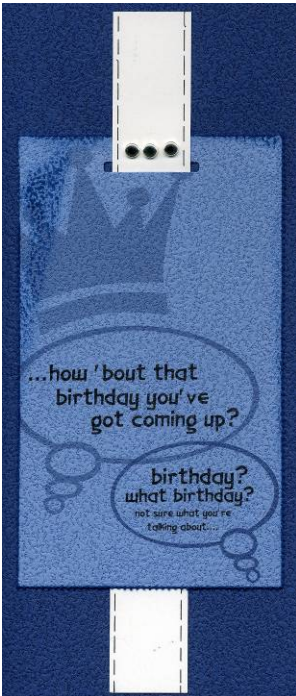


Card #2



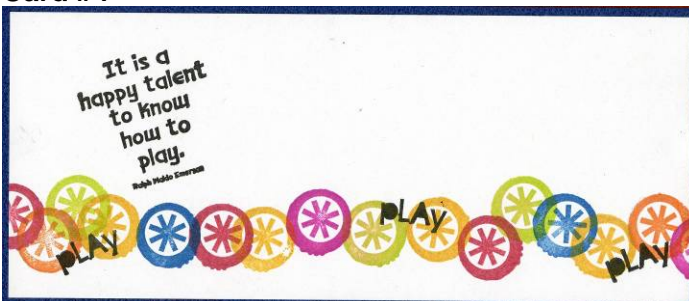
- Dark Blue Card with White Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds and Font
1. Stamp the UM circle and checkered borders onto the White panel with black ink. Color in the circular images with colored pencils or watercolors.
 2. Stamp "URAQT" with the UM Font. Layer the panel onto the card.

Card #3



- Dark Blue Card with White Panel
 - Light Blue Perforated Die Cut: "Birthday? What Birthday?"
 - (3) Silver Brads
1. Trim the White panel vertically at 2.75" to create a 1" strip. Add dashed lines to the edges of the strip with a ruler and fine tip pen.
 2. Thread the 1" White strip through the die cut and secure with three silver brads. Layer onto the card. Attach the remaining White panel to the inside of the card.

Card #4



- Dark Blue Card with White Panel
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds and Font
1. Stamp the UM Font's "O" image across the bottom of the White panel in assorted bright colors.
 2. Stamp the UM "Play" image three times within the stamped border with black ink. Add the stamped quote and layer the panel onto the card.



Card #5



- Dark Blue Card with White Panel
 - White Die Cut Tag: "Happy Birthday"
1. Trim the White panel vertically at 2.75" to create a 1" strip. Stamp the strip with assorted colorful ink cubes, if desired, and thread the strip through the tag.
 2. Secure the tag and strip to the Dark Blue card. Attach the remaining 2.75" strip to the inside of the card.

Set C: 5x7" White Cards with 4-3/4x6-3/4" Chrome Panels

Card #1



- White Card with Chrome Panel
 - Light Blue Perforated Tag: "Happy Birthday"
 - Colorful Paper Scraps
 - Blue Grid Ribbon
1. Crumple the Chrome panel, tear the edges slightly, and staple onto the White card.
 2. Punch or cut small shapes from the colorful paper scraps and attach to the Light Blue tag. Top the tag with fiber and layer onto the panel.

Card #2



- White Card with Two Chrome Panels
 - White Die Cut Tags: "Birthday Boy"
 - Light Blue Perforated Tags: "It's," "Your" and "Day"
 - Light Blue Satin Ribbon
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Trim the Chrome panel vertically at 2.5". Set aside the 2.5x6.75" panel for the next card. Stamp the UM circle border image onto the back side of the remaining Chrome strip with blue ink. Trim the strip to the width of the stamped border and attach to the bottom of the panel.
 2. String the Light Blue tags onto the ribbon and knot each ribbon end. Attach the tags to the panel with foam adhesive.
 3. Add the White tags to the panel and layer the panel onto the card.

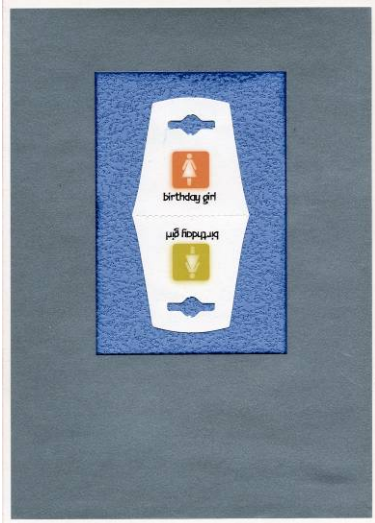


Card #3



- White Card with 2.5x6.75" Chrome Panel
 - UM Font and Borders & Backgrounds
 - (2) Silver Brads
 - White Die Cut Tags: "Happy" and "Birthday"
1. Temporarily place a gift card at an angle onto the back center of the Chrome panel. Lightly mark the top and bottom of the card. Using a grid ruler, craft knife and cutting mat, make two vertically angled slits in the panel about .75" apart, stopping at the marked guidelines. The gift card will fit right into the slot.
 2. Stamp the greeting at the bottom of the panel with solvent ink and allow to dry.
 3. Attach the two White die cuts with silver brads and layer the panel onto the card.

Card #4



- White Card with Chrome Panel
 - 2.5x3.75 Light Blue Panel (Set A, Card 3)
 - White Die Cut Tag: "Birthday Girl"
1. Center the White tag onto the Light Blue panel and layer onto the upper center of the Chrome panel. Attach the panel to the card.

Card #5



- White Card with Chrome Panel
 - Light Blue Satin Ribbon
 - White Die Cut Tags: "Thank" and "You"
 - Light Blue Perforated Tag: "I Can't Thank You Enough"
1. Fold the Chrome panel many times at different angles to create a random textured background; attach the panel to the card.
 2. Staple three ribbons onto the Light Blue tag and attach to the upper left corner of the panel. Adhere the White tags to the lower right corner.
