- Apothecary Unmounted Borders & Backgrounds*
- Apothecary CS® Wood Mounted Mortar and Pestle Stamp*
- Apothecary Wood Mounted "Get Well Soon"*
- Apothecary Wood Mounted "Happy Birthday" Stamp*

Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making creases, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of many finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.

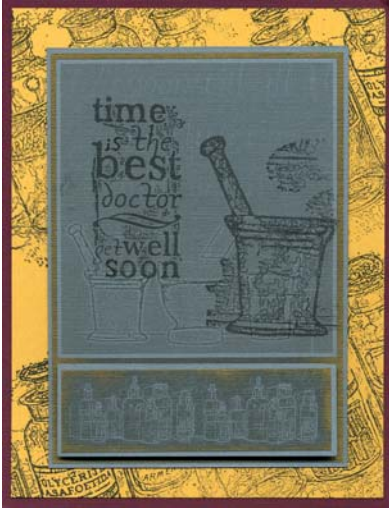
Trim the 12x12 Dark Grey Cutaparts according to the pre-printed cutting guidelines.

If you do not have an item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use items that you have in your stash.



Set A: 4-1/4 x 5-1/2" Wine Cards with Gold Panels

Card #1



- Wine Card with Gold Panel
 - Dark Grey Cutaparts: Large Frame and Bottle Strip
 - WM Mortar and Pestle Stamp
 - WM "Get Well Soon" Stamp
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM bottle image onto the Gold panel with Onyx ink to create a background.
 2. Layer the Dark Grey bottle strip onto the bottom portion of the large frame with foam tape.
 3. Stamp a small portion of the WM mortar and pestle image onto the right side of the frame, and stamp the greeting at left.
 4. Attach the Grey cutapart and Gold panel to the card.

Card #2



- Wine Card with Gold Panel
 - Dark Grey Cutapart: Large Frame
 - Wine Die Cut: "Happy Birthday" Clip
 - WM "Happy Birthday" Stamp
1. Stamp the greeting onto the trimmed Dark Grey panel. Attach the Wine die cut clip to the panel.
 2. Layer onto the Gold panel and Wine card.

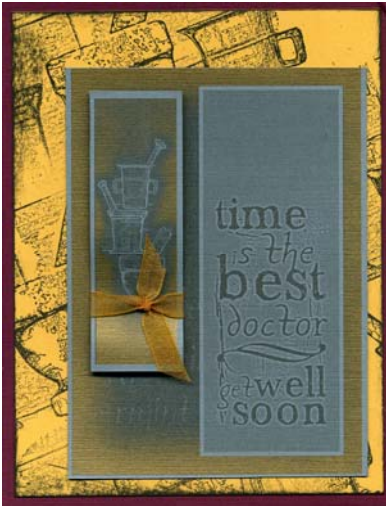
Card #3



- Wine Card with Gold Panel
 - Dark Grey Cutapart: "Just What the Doctor Ordered"
 - Wine Die Cuts: "Hello" and "Smile!"
 - WM "Get Well Soon" Stamp
1. Clip the Wine die cuts onto the upper left and lower right corners of the Dark Grey cutapart.
 2. Stamp the "get well" image onto the left side of the cutapart with Onyx ink. Layer onto the Gold panel and Wine card.

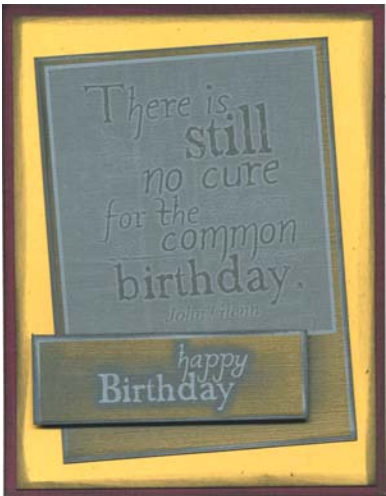


Card #4



- Wine Card with Gold Panel
 - Dark Grey Cutapart: "Get Well Soon" and Stacked Mortar & Pestle
 - Gold Organza
 - WM Mortar and Pestle Stamp
1. Stamp the mortar and pestle image at an angle onto the Gold panel with Onyx ink; layer onto the Wine card.
 2. Tie gold organza onto the Dark Grey cutapart strip and attach to the larger Dark Grey cutapart with foam tape. Layer onto the card.

Card #5



- Wine Card with Gold Panel
 - Dark Grey Cutaparts: "Still No Cure..." and "Happy Birthday"
1. Layer the Dark Grey "happy birthday" strip onto the larger panel with foam tape at an angle, as shown.
 2. Nest the cutaparts onto the Gold panel and Wine card.

Set B: 5x7" Gold Cards with Dark Grey and Light Grey Panels

Card #1



- Gold Card with Dark Grey and Light Grey Panels
 - (4) Wine Mini Brads
 - Wine Satin Ribbon
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp the UM quote and bottle trio onto the Light Grey panel with Onyx ink. Color the bottles with watercolors, and splatter the panel randomly.
 2. Attach the Light Grey panel to the Dark Grey panel with brads, and layer onto the Gold card. Finish with a satin bow.

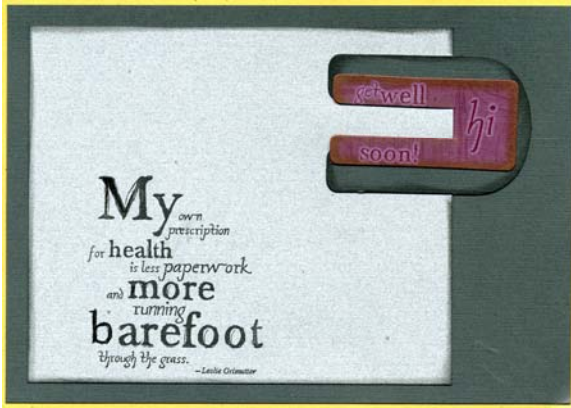


Card #2



- Gold Card with Dark Grey and Light Grey Panels
 - WM Mortar and Pestle Stamp
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Stamp and heat emboss the WM stamp image with Onyx ink and clear embossing powder at an angle onto the Light Grey panel. Color and splatter the embossed image with watercolors.
 2. Stamp the UM quote onto the upper right corner of the panel. Distress edges and staple onto the Dark Grey panel. Layer the panels onto the card.

Card #3



- Gold Card with Dark Grey and Light Grey Panels
 - Dark Grey Die Cut: Large Three-Prong Clip
 - Wine Die Cut: Small "Get Well Soon" Clip
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
1. Trim the Light Grey panel horizontally at 5". Stamp the UM greeting onto the lower left corner.
 2. Nest the die cut clips and attach to the Light Grey Panel, as shown. Layer onto the Dark Grey panel and card.

Card #4



- Gold Card with Dark Grey and Light Grey Panels
 - Dark Grey Cutapart: "Apothecary"
 - Wine Die Cut: "The Greatest Healing..."
 - UM Borders & Backgrounds
 - Gold Organza
 - Gold Paperclip
1. Stamp the UM scale image at an angle onto the Light Grey panel with Onyx ink to create a background.
 2. Attach a gold clip to the Wine die cut and layer onto the Dark Grey cutapart. Adhere to the Light Grey panel.
 3. Tie gold organza around the bottom of the Light Grey panel and make a small bow. Layer onto the Dark Grey panel and Gold card.



Card #5



- Gold Card with Dark Grey and Light Grey Panels
- Dark Grey Die Cut: Long Multi Clip
- Dark Grey Cutapart: Scale
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- (2) Gold Brads
- (3) Silver Brads

1. Trim the Light Grey panel vertically at 2.75". Layer the Dark Grey cutapart onto the panel and stamp the UM greeting below.
2. Trim the Dark Grey panel vertically at 3.75". Stamp the Dark Grey die cut clip repeatedly with the UM text noise. Thread the clip onto the left edge of the panel and attach brads, as shown.
3. Layer the Light Grey and Dark Grey panels onto the Gold card.

Set C: 4 x 9-1/4" Dark Grey Cards with Wine Panels

Card #1



- Dark Grey Card with Wine Panel
- Dark Grey Cutapart: "I Hope Tomorrow..."
- WM Mortar and Pestle Stamp
- Wine Satin Ribbon

1. Stamp and emboss the WM image with Onyx ink and clear powder onto the Wine panel. Brush white watercolor onto the background to create a faux bleach effect.
2. Make a bow with the wine ribbon and layer behind the Dark Grey cutapart. Attach the panel to the card.

Card #2

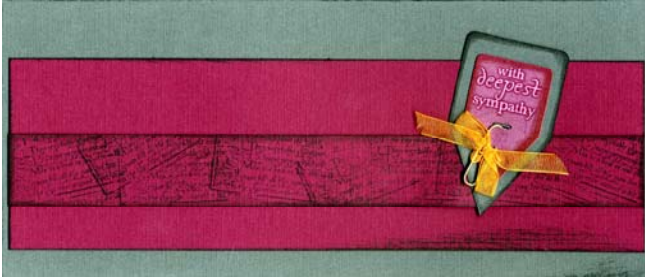


- Dark Grey Card with Wine Panel
- Wine Die Cut: "We Hope You..."
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Trim the Wine panel vertically at 2.75". Attach the Wine die cut to the panel, choosing the words to make up the desired greeting.
2. Stamp "happiness" into the lower right corner and attach the panel to the card.



Card #3



- Dark Grey Card with Wine Panel
- Dark Grey Die Cut: Large Clip
- Wine Die Cut: "With Deepest Sympathy"
- Gold Paper Clip
- Gold Organza Ribbon
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Trim the Wine panel vertically at 2.75". Stamp the 1" strip repeatedly with the text image from the UM sheet with Onyx ink.
2. Nest the two die cut clips and attach to the narrow strip with a gold paper clip. Tie a gold organza bow around the clip.
3. Layer the stamped Wine strip onto the remaining portion of the panel and attach to the Dark Grey card.

Card #4



- Dark Grey Card with Wine Panel
- Dark Grey Die Cut: Large Circular Ribbon Slide
- Wine Die Cut: Small Circular Ribbon Slide
- Gold Organza and Wine Satin Ribbon
- UM Borders & Backgrounds

1. Stamp the UM "happiness" image into the upper right corner of the Wine panel with Onyx ink.
2. Thread the wine satin ribbon through the Dark Grey die cut and attach horizontally to the Wine panel. Thread the gold organza ribbon through the Wine die cut and attach vertically to the Wine panel. Layer the panel onto the card.

Card #5



- Dark Grey Card with Wine Panel
- Dark Grey Cutapart: Vertical Bottle
- Dark Grey Die Cut: Large Clip
- Wine Die Cut: "Thanks!" Clip
- Gold Paper Clip

1. Nest the Dark Grey and Wine die cuts and attach with a gold paper clip.
2. Attach the clip to the Dark Grey cutapart, and layer onto the Wine panel and Dark Grey card.
