Tools:

- 12" Paper Trimmer
- 3x13" CS® Grid Ruler
- Adhesive
- Tape
- Vellum Adhesive
- Gold Photo Mounting Corners
- 12x12 Paper (of any kind)
- Tonic Paper Distressing Tool
- Craft Knife and Cutting Mat

Fraction to Decimal Conversions

$1/8" = .125"$ $1/2" = .5"$ $7/8" = .875"$

$1/4" = .25"$ $5/8" = .625"$

$3/8" = .375"$ $3/4" = .75"$

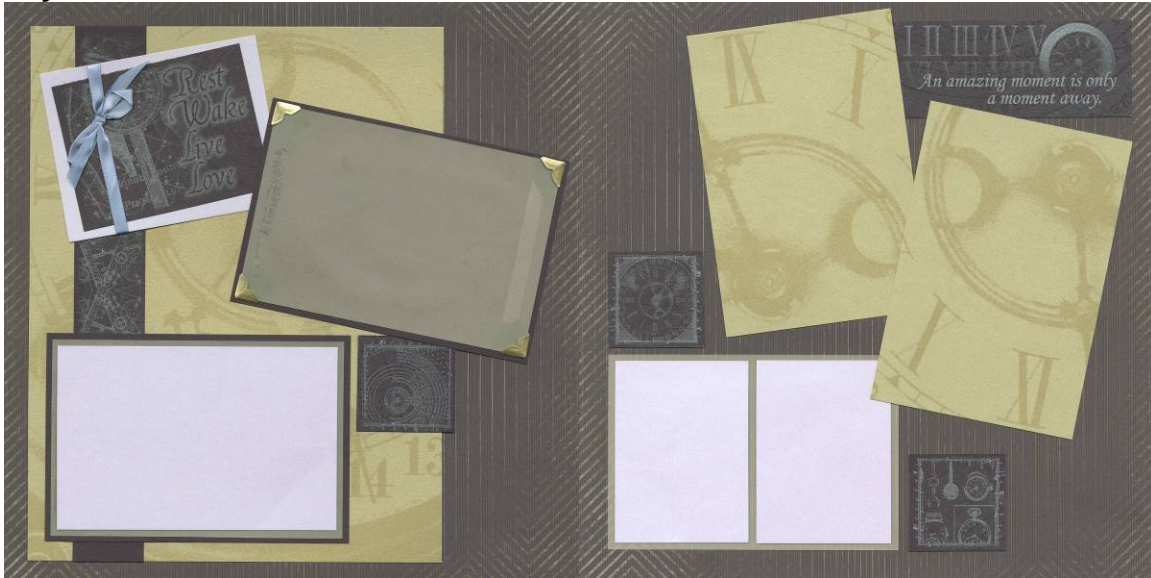


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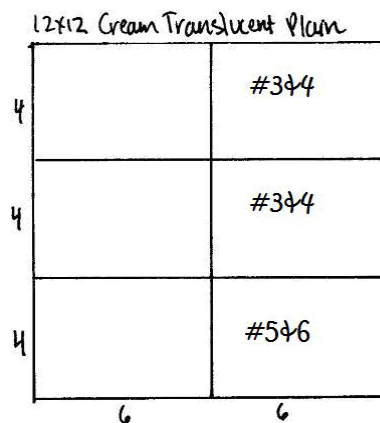
Preparation: Trim all Plum Cutapart elements into single images by following the tiny suggested cutting guidelines.

Layout #1 and #2

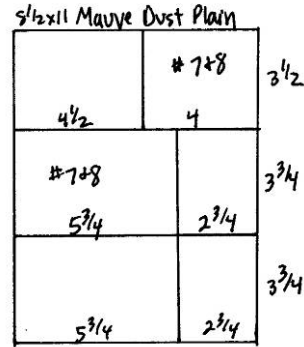


- (2) 12x12 Eggplant Pinstripe Print
- 12x12 Cream Translucent Plain
- 8.5x11 Gold Print
- 8.5x11 Mauve Dust Plain
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Gold Print Photo Mattes
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Plum Plain Photo Mattes
- Plum Cutaparts
- Gold Photo Mounting Corners
- Lavender Satin Ribbon

1. Cut the 12x12 Cream Translucent at 6". Cut each 6x12 piece horizontally at 8 and 4". (Three 4x6 pieces will be used in future layouts.)



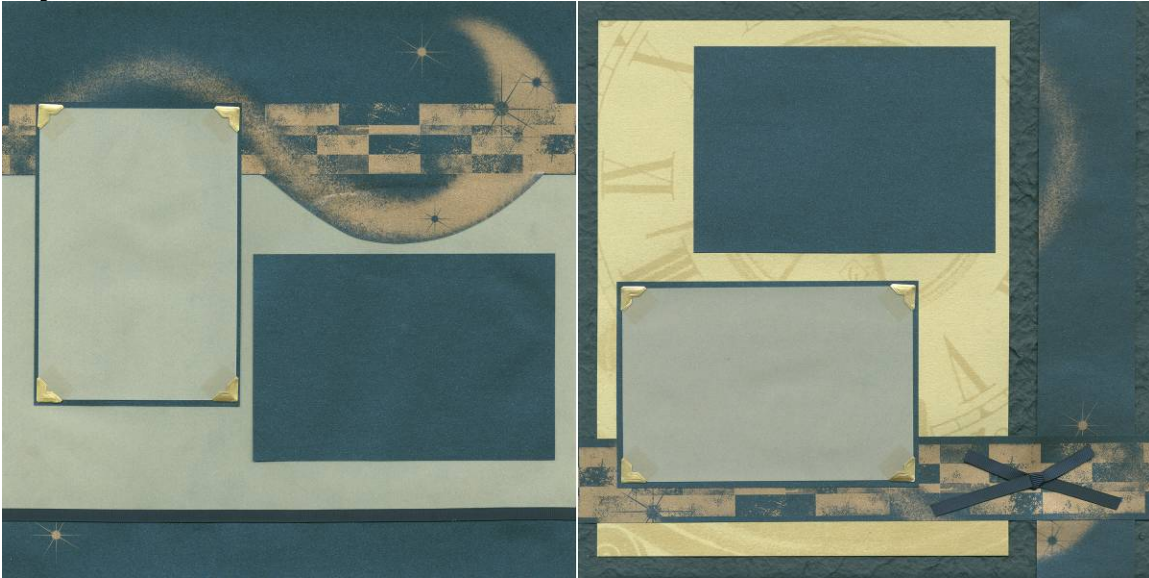
2. Cut the 8.5x11 Mauve Dust Plain horizontally at 7.25 and 3.5". Trim the 3.5x8.5 horizontally at 4.5". Cut each 3.75x8.5 horizontally at 5.75".



3. Hiding adhesive when attaching vellum is still a challenge, even with amazing advances in adhesive products! When using as a photo matte, there is less need to worry about the adhesive being visible, because it will be covered by the photo. In this case, I attached the matte with gold photo mounting corners. Translucent papers make great layers for double and triple photo mattes.
4. Nest each 2.75x3.75 Mauve Dust piece side by side on the 4x6 Translucent Plain. The two pieces should perfectly with an even border around all sides. Two horizontal or vertical photos can be cropped to fit into the spaces.
5. Layer the large Plum "Rest, Wake, Live, Love" Cutapart onto the 3.5x4.5 Mauve Dust piece; wrap the nested image with the satin ribbon.

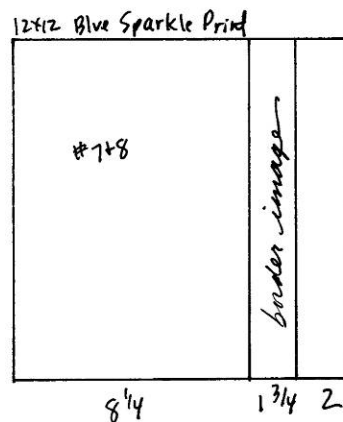


Layout #3 and #4

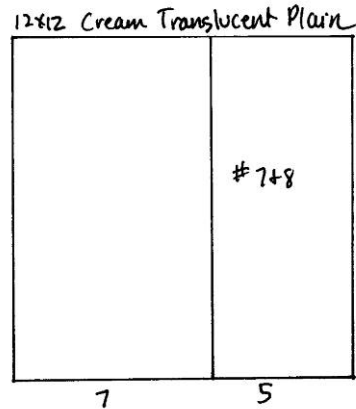


- (2) 12x12 Blue Sparkle Print
- 12x12 Blue Handmade
- 12x12 Cream Translucent Plain
- 8.5x11 Gold Print
- (4) 4.25x6.25 Blue Sparkle Photo Mattes
- (2) 4x6 Cream Translucent Plain (From Layout #1 and #2)
- Gold Photo Mounting Corners
- Blue Grosgrain Ribbon
- 12x12 Paper (of any kind)

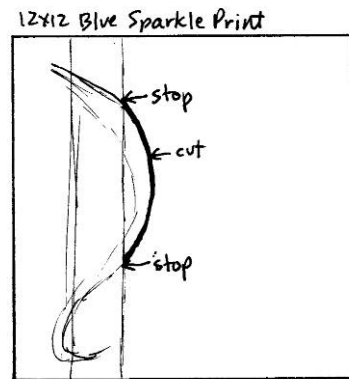
1. Place one 12x12 Blue Sparkle Print into the trimmer with the border strip running vertically along the right edge. Trim at 10 and 8.25".



2. Cut the 12x12 Cream Translucent Plain at 7".



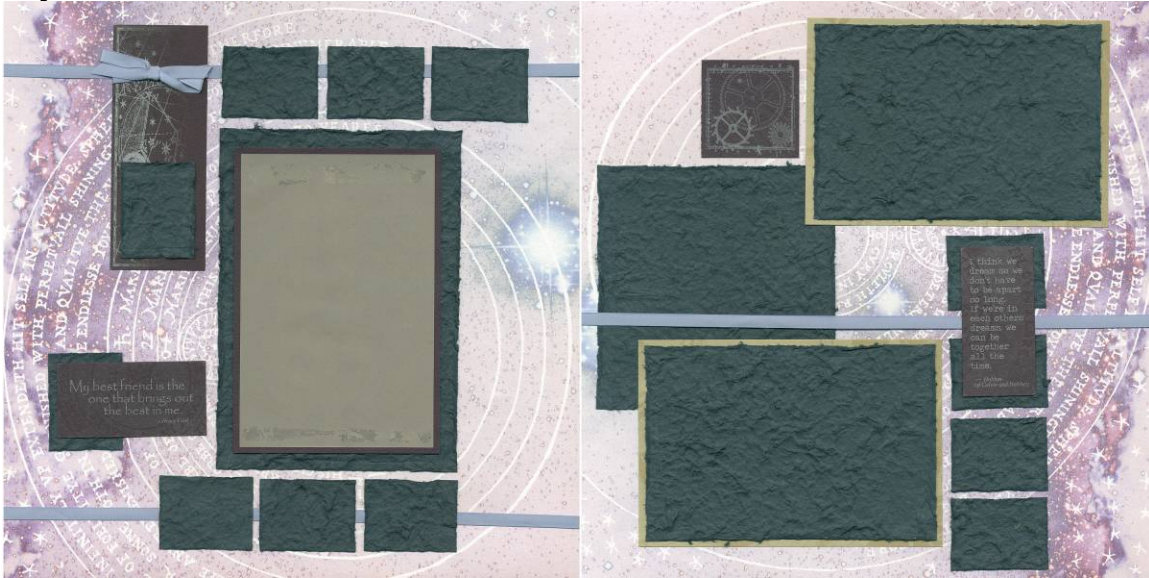
3. Place the remaining 12x12 Blue Sparkle Print onto a cutting mat. Cut along the curved line, starting and ending at the straight border strip.



4. Slide the 7x12 Cream Translucent beneath the flap cut into the 12x12 Blue Sparkle Print. Trim a 13" length of blue grosgrain ribbon and run along the lower edge of the Cream Translucent; wrap ribbon ends around to the back and secure with tape. Stabilize the pair of papers by layering onto a piece of 12x12 paper of any kind.
5. Tie a small bow with blue grosgrain ribbon, and attach to the lower right corner of the right page after assembly.

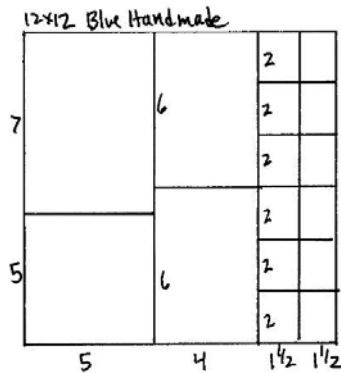


Layout #5 and #6



- (2) 12x12 Star White Map Print
- 12x12 Blue Handmade
- 4.25x6.25 Plum Photo Matte
- (2) 4.25x6.25 Gold Print Photo Mattes
- 4x6 Cream Translucent (From Layout #1 and #2)
- Plum Cutaparts
- Lavender Satin Ribbon
- Tonic Paper Distressing Tool

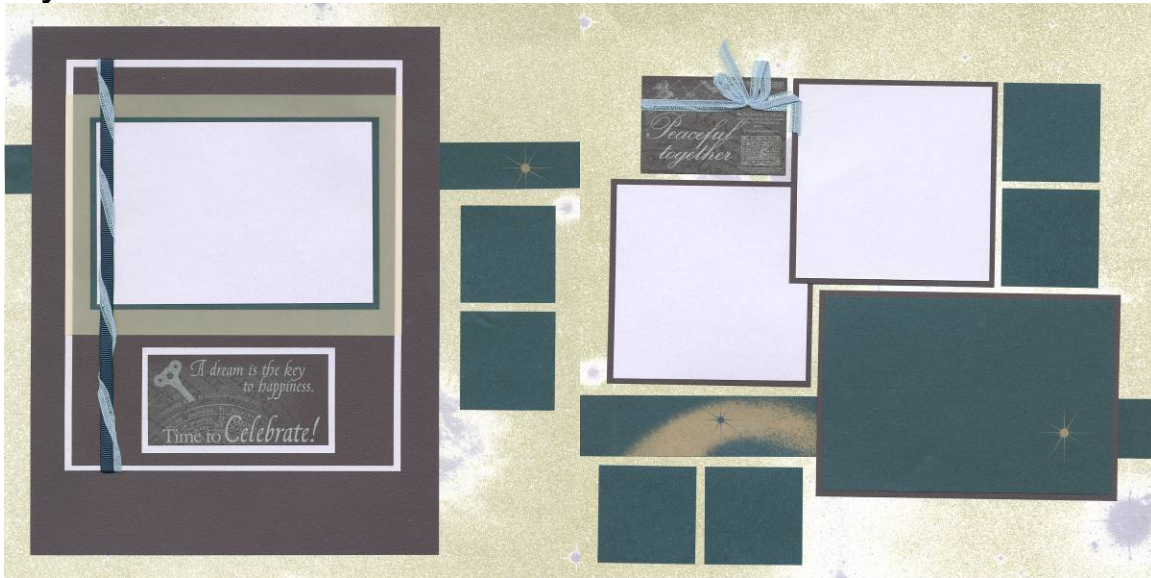
1. Cut the 12x12 Blue Handmade at 10.5, 9, and 5. Trim the 5x12 horizontally at 7". Cut the 4x12 horizontally at 6". Trim each 1.5x12 strip horizontally at 10, 8, 6, 4, and 2. (This diagram is inspired by the *ALSB Idea Deck, Five of Spades.*)



2. Distress the edges of the handmade paper pieces to create a more natural-looking edge.
3. Arrange all page elements before attaching anything to the layout. Tie a bow around the tall, narrow Plum die cut featured on the upper left corner of the left page. Align the tied bow with the length of ribbon attached to the page to create a "fake" tie. Works like a charm!

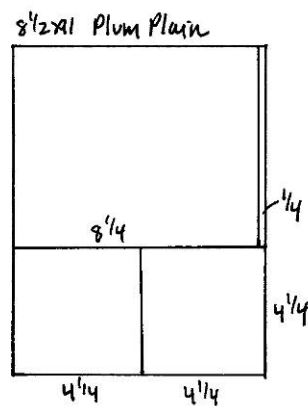


Layout #7 and #8

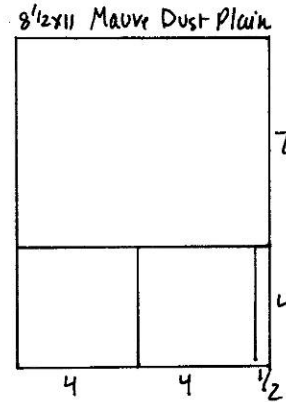


- (2) 12x12 Star White Galaxy Print
- (2) 8.5x11 Plum Plain
- 8.5x11 Mauve Dust Plain
- 4.25x6.25 Plum Photo Matte
- 8.25x12 Blue Sparkle Print (From Layout #3 and #4)
- 5x12 Cream Translucent (From Layout #3 and #4)
- 3.75x5.75 Mauve Dust Plain (From Layout #1 and #2)
- 3.5x4 Mauve Dust Plain (From Layout #1 and #2)
- Plum Cutaparts
- Blue Grosgrain Ribbon
- Pale Blue Rayon Ribbon

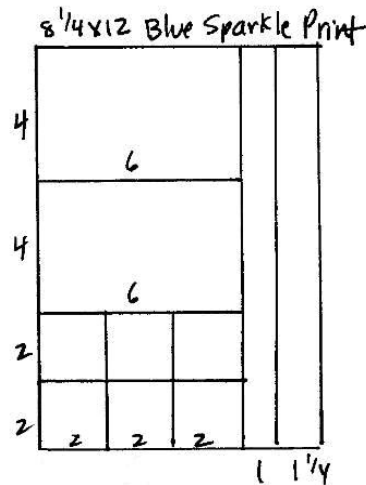
1. Cut one 8.5x11 Plum Plain horizontally at 6.75. Trim the 6.75x8.5 horizontally at 8.25". Cut the 4.25x8.5 horizontally at 4.25".



- Cut the 8.5x11 Mauve Dust Plain horizontally at 7". Trim the 4x8.5 horizontally at 8 and 4".



- Trim the 8.25x12 Blue Sparkle Print vertically at 7 and 6". Cut the 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4". Trim one 4x6 vertically at 2". Cut each 2x6 strip horizontally at 4 and 2".



- Nest the 6.75x8.25 Plum onto the 7x8.5 Mauve Dust. Wrap the 5x12 Translucent piece horizontally around the top half of the nested pieces, securing paper ends at the back with adhesive. Place a 4x6 Blue Sparkle and 3.75x5.75 Mauve Dust matte onto the Translucent band.
- Attach the ends of the blue grosgrain and pale blue rayon ribbon to the back edge of the nested pieces with tape; wind the rayon ribbon around the grosgrain ribbon several times to create a braided look, and secure the ribbon ends at the other end with tape.
- Cut the 3.5x4 Mauve Dust Plain to matte the "Time to Celebrate" cutapart.
