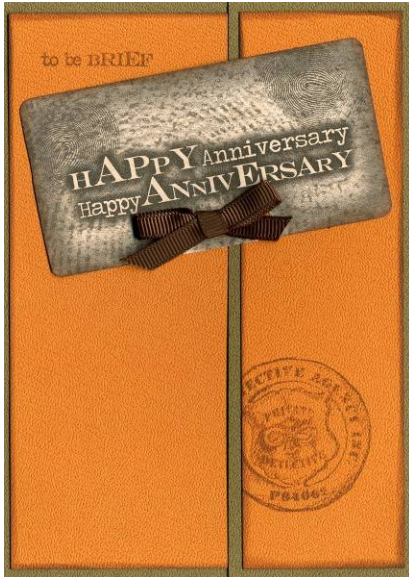
*Fold all cards along score lines and reinforce creases with a bone folder. Before making crease, check to make sure that all edges are aligned. The edges of most finished cards, panels and die cuts have been colored with black or brown ink. This step is optional, and the directions to ink edges are not included below. For a softer look, ink with a sponge or stylus tool with blender tip. For a bolder effect, ink directly from the pad onto the card.*

*If you do not have the item needed to complete the card as it is shown, simply eliminate the step, or modify it to use the items that you have in your stash.*



## Set A: 4-1/2 x 6-1/4 Brown Gate Fold Card with Ginger Panels

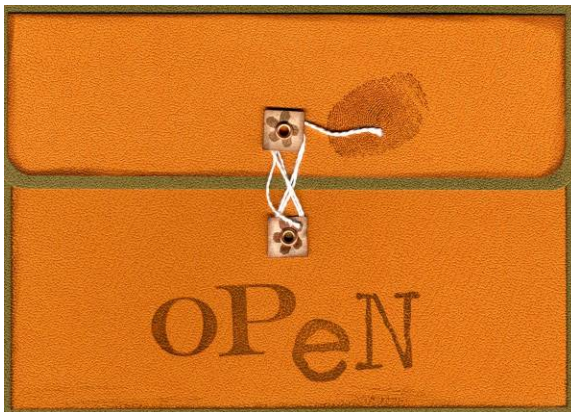
### Card #1



- Brown Gate Fold Card with Ginger Panels
- Kraft Die Cut Tag: "Happy Anniversary"
- Brown Grosgrain Ribbon
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Earth Ink
- Glue Lines

1. Tie the ribbon into a bow and attach to the bottom of the die cut with a Glue Line.
2. Stamp the UM images onto the Ginger panels with Earth ink; attach the panels to the card.
3. Attach the Kraft die cut to the narrow panel only.

### Card #2

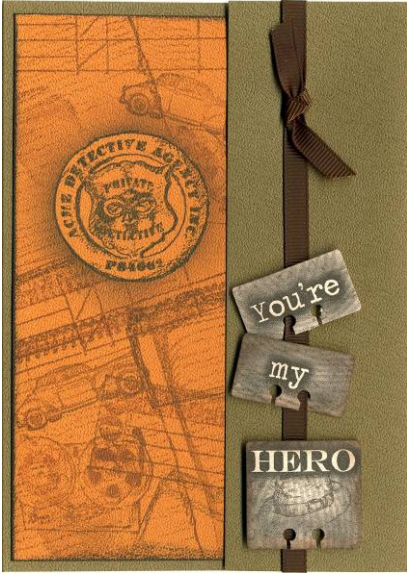


- Brown Gate Fold Card with Ginger Panels
- UM Font and UM Borders & Backgrounds
- White String and Copper Eyelets
- Square Punch and Corner Rounder Punch
- Kraft Plain
- Earth Ink

1. Round the bottom corners of the horizontal narrow Ginger panel and the corners of the narrow flap on the card.
2. Punch two small squares from Kraft Plain. Punch a hole in the center of each square.
3. Temporarily place the Ginger panels on the Brown card to help with hole placement. Measure and mark the center of each Ginger panel. Punch holes, as shown. Attach punched squares onto the holes in each panel with eyelets.
4. Adhere the panels onto the card. Stamp the word "open" onto the lower panel, and the thumbprint onto the upper panel with Earth ink. Stamp a greeting inside.
5. Wrap white string around the eyelets to create a closure.



### Card #3



- Brown Gate Fold Card with Ginger Panels
  - Kraft Die Cuts: "You're My Hero"
  - Brown Grosgrain Ribbon
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Earth and Black Ink
  - Post-It Note
  - Foam Tape
1. Stamp the wide Ginger panel with the UM badge image in black ink. Stamp same image onto a Post-it Note and trim to create a mask. Place the mask over the stamped image on panel. Sponge black ink around the perimeter of the mask.
  2. Stamp assorted UM images onto the Ginger panel with Earth ink. Remove the mask and attach the panel to the card.
  3. Wrap a length of ribbon around the narrow gate fold; secure ribbon ends at back with tape and cover tape with narrow Ginger panel. Tie a bow onto the ribbon.
  4. Mount three Kraft die cuts as shown with foam tape.

### Card #4



- Brown Gate Fold Card with Narrow Ginger Panel
  - WM "Brief Case" Stamp
  - UM Font and UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Kraft Die Cut: "Do I Detect an Anniversary?"
  - Black and Earth Ink
  - Paper for Masking
1. Using black ink, stamp the UM car image onto the lower left corner of the narrow Ginger panel. Use a paper mask and sponge to create a faux headlight glow with Earth ink.
  2. Attach the panel to the card and layer the Kraft die cut onto the right side of the panel.
  3. Stamp the brief case and "Case Closed" onto the bottom portion of the card.



### Card #5



- Brown Gate Fold Card with Wide Ginger Panel
- Rust Perforated Die Cuts: "Get Well," "Feeling Blue," "Hope This Finds You..." and "Keepin' On"
- Stapler
- Rust Ribbon

1. Attach the wide Ginger panel to the wide gate fold of the card.
2. Leave the gang of Rust tags together. Staple a 2" length of rust ribbon onto the top of each tag.
3. Layer the tags at an angle onto the wide Ginger panel. Leave the upper portion of the tags void of adhesive so that the short gate fold of the card can slide beneath the tags.

### Set B: 4-3/4 x 7-1/4 Green Cards with Kraft Panels

#### Card #1



- Green Card with Kraft Panel
- Rust Die Cuts: "Super Job" and "You Rock!"
- Kraft Die Cut: "Let Me See..."
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Earth Ink

1. Stamp the Kraft panel with the UM notebook image and Earth ink. Layer the panel onto the card.
2. Attach the Kraft and Rust die cuts to the card as shown.

#### Card #2

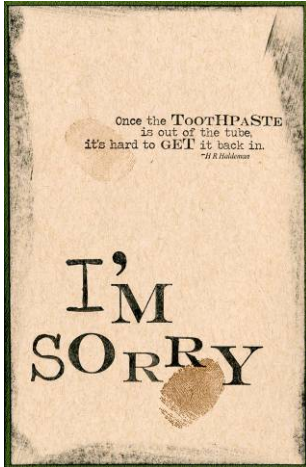


- Green Card with Kraft Panel
- Kraft Die Cut: "Happy Birthday!"
- Rust Die Cut: "Enjoy!"
- WM "Brief Case" and UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Brown Grosgrain Ribbon
- Post-It Note
- Black Ink

1. Create a mask with the WM brief case stamp. Stamp a row of brief cases across the bottom of the Kraft panel with black ink, masking each time. Cut along the bottom edges of the cases.
2. Thread the Kraft die cut with brown ribbon and attach to the panel.
3. Place the Rust die cut onto the panel and attach the panel to the card.



**Card #3**



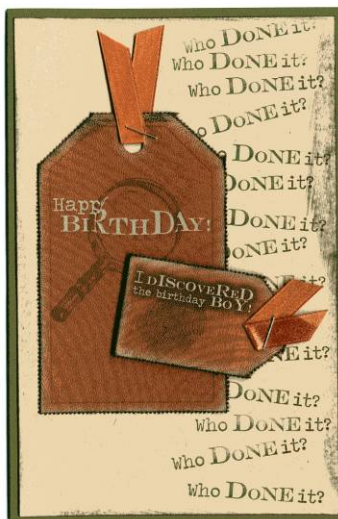
- Green Card with Kraft Panel
  - UM Fonts and UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Earth and Black Ink
1. Stamp the UM toothpaste quote onto the panel with black ink.
  2. Stamp "I'm Sorry" onto the card with the UM Font and black ink.
  3. Add two UM fingerprint images to the panel and attach the panel to the card.

**Card #4**



- Green Card with Kraft Panel
  - Kraft Die Cuts: "My Spies Tell Me" and "Get Well Soon"
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - WM "Finger Print Chart"
  - Earth and Black Ink
  - Brown Grosgrain Ribbon
1. Stamp the fingerprint chart onto the lower right corner of the card with Earth ink. Ink and roll fingertips into the appropriate boxes.
  2. Attach the Kraft die cuts as shown and accent with UM quotes stamped in black ink. Layer panel onto card.

**Card #5**

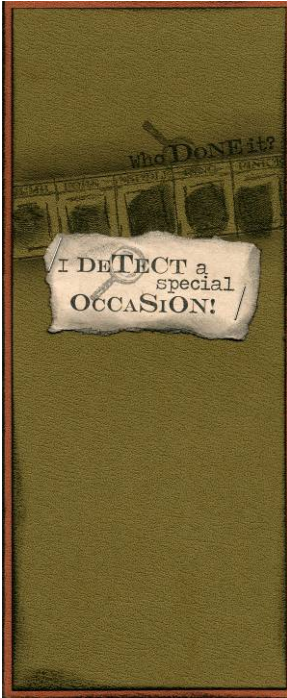


- Green Card with Kraft Panel
  - Rust Die Cuts: "Happy Birthday" and "I Discovered..."
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - Rust Ribbon
  - Stapler
  - Black Ink
1. Stamp the UM "Who Done It?" image onto the right side of the Kraft panel with black ink.
  2. Staple ribbons onto the top of each Rust tag. Layer onto the panel as shown; attach the panel to the card.



## Set C: 3-7/8 x 9-1/4 Rust Cards with Brown Panels

### Card #1



- Rust Card with Brown Panel
  - WM "Special Occasion" Stamp
  - WM Fingerprint Chart Stamp
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - UM Font
  - Kraft Plain
  - Black Ink
1. Stamp the "Special Occasion" image onto the Kraft paper with black ink. Tear around the stamped image and sponge edges with black ink.
  2. Stamp the fingerprint chart onto the Brown panel with black ink as shown. Roll fingers across inkpad and print in specified boxes.
  3. Stamp the UM "Who Done It" image just above the fingerprint chart with black ink. The tiny magnifying glass image is on the UM Font sheet...stamp that, too!
  4. Attach the stamped quote to the panel and the panel to the card.

### Card #2

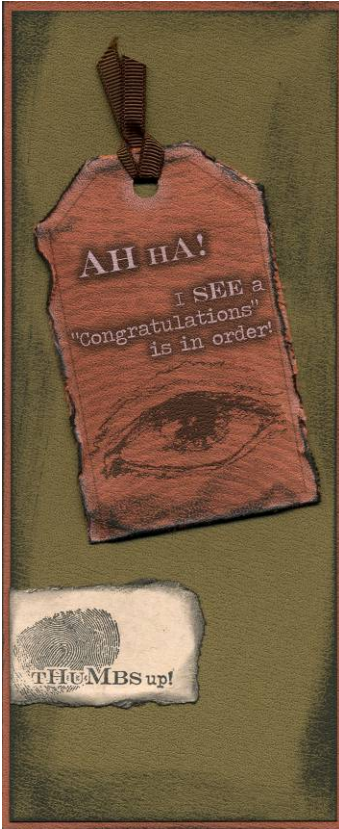


- Rust Card with Brown Panel
- Kraft Die Cut: "Another Birthday..."
- Rust Ribbon
- UM Font
- UM Borders & Backgrounds
- Black and Earth Ink

1. Using the UM font, stamp "{Hb2u}" onto the upper left corner of the panel with black ink.
2. Thread a length of rust ribbon through the bottom of the Kraft die cut. Attach the die cut to the panel. Stamp the UM thumbprint image into the center of the magnifying glass with Earth ink.
3. Stamp "Who Done It?" just above the Kraft die cut with black ink.



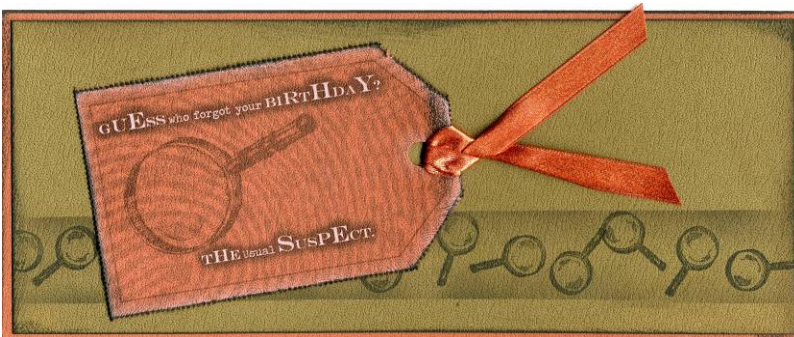
### Card #3



- Rust Card with Brown Panel
- Rust Die Cut: "Ah Ha!"
- Kraft Plain
- WM "Thumbs Up" Image
- Black Ink
- Paper Distressing Tool
- Brown Grosgrain Ribbon

1. Stamp "Thumbs Up!" onto a piece of Kraft with black ink. Tear out the image and cut a clean edge on the left side. Attach the image to the Brown panel.
2. Distress and ink the perimeter of the Rust tag. Top with brown ribbon and layer onto the panel.
3. Attach the panel to the card.

### Card #4

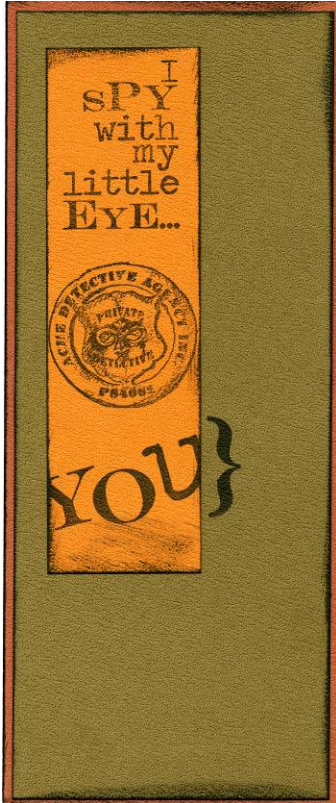


- Rust Card with Brown Panel
- Rust Die Cut: "The Usual Suspect"
- Rust Ribbon
- Paper for Masking
- UM Font
- Black Ink

1. Stamp the UM Font's magnifying glass across the bottom of the panel. Mask the area and sponge with ink to create a distinct border.
2. Top the Rust die cut with ribbon and attach to the panel at an angle. Layer the panel onto the card.



**Card #5**



- Rust Card with Brown Panel
  - Narrow Ginger Panel (from Set A)
  - UM Borders & Backgrounds
  - UM Font
  - Black Ink
1. Stamp "I Spy..." onto the top of the Ginger panel with black ink.
  2. Stamp the UM badge image onto the center of the panel with black ink.
  3. Stamp "You" onto the lower portion of the panel with the UM Font.
  4. Layer the Ginger panel onto the Brown panel. Stamp the UM bracket image next to the word, "You."
  5. Attach the Brown panel to the card.
