

# Holiday Glow Lamp Project

2010 WOW Holiday Workshop



## Project Kit

- 10<sup>3/8</sup>x5<sup>1/2</sup> Ivory Die Cut Frame
- (4) 9<sup>1/2</sup>x5<sup>3/8</sup> Translucent Shades
- (2) 1/2x2<sup>3/4</sup> Short Walls
- (2) 1/2x3 Long Walls
- (2) 5x5 Book Board Base Level One
- (2) 4<sup>3/4</sup>x4<sup>3/4</sup> Book Board Base Level Two
- (2) 4<sup>1/2</sup>x1<sup>1/2</sup> Book Board Base Level Three
- Battery Operated Candle
- 1 oz. Jar Raw Umber Acrylic Paint
- (2) Foam Brushes

## Other Supplies Needed

- CS® Bookbinding Glue
- CS® Grid Ruler
- CS® Onyx Ink
- Score-It Board (Optional) and Bone Folder
- WOW Holiday Unmounted Stamps
- Faber-Castell Gelatos
- Acrylic Mounting Block
- Watercolor Pencils, Crayons, Markers and Stamps
- Waterbrush or Paintbrush
- Ball Point Pen or Permanent Marker and Pencil

1. Glue the 4<sup>1/2</sup>x4<sup>1/2</sup>" *Book Board Base Level Three* pieces together. Repeat for the 4<sup>3/4</sup>x4<sup>3/4</sup>" and 5x5" *Book Board Base* pieces to create three layers. Glue the base layers together from largest to smallest, leaving an equal border around the outside edges.
2. Identify the two 1/2x2<sup>3/4</sup>" *Short Walls* and 1/2x3" *Long Walls*. Glue the edge of a short wall to the face of a long wall to form a 90° angle. Glue the other short wall to the face of the long wall to create a second 90° angle. Finish by attaching the last long wall to form a 3" square frame.
3. Apply glue to the outside edge of the 3" book board frame and center onto the top of the book board base. There will be a 3/4" reveal on all four sides.



4. Using a foam brush, paint the entire base with acrylic paint. Repeat with a second coat, if needed.
5. Remove the rectangular windows from the Ivory die cut. Fold along all scored lines to make a frame. Glue the narrow tab of the die cut to the inside of the frame. Paint, stamp or decorate the frame, if desired. Insert into the base with the widest edge of the frame at the bottom.
6. Using a ruler and bone folder or Scor-it Board, score each  $9\frac{1}{2} \times 5\frac{3}{8}$  *Translucent Shade* horizontally every  $2\frac{3}{8}$ " to create four panels.
7. Place one scored shade horizontally on your work surface with the indented side of the score lines facing up. Draw a pencil guideline  $\frac{3}{4}$ " from the bottom edge and  $\frac{1}{4}$ " from the top edge. Adjacent to the  $\frac{3}{4}$ " and  $\frac{1}{2}$ " guidelines, use a ruler and pencil to mark the center of each scored area.
8. Place the unmounted candle image onto an acrylic mounting block. Using a ball point pen or permanent marker and ruler, mark the center of the stamp image at top and bottom, bringing mark around to the back of the stamp. If using a grid-etched mount, position the stamp at exactly center.
9. Ink and stamp the image onto each of the scored panels with black ink, using the marked guides for centering the image. Allow the ink to dry completely.
10. Turn the shade over to the unstamped side. Color the stamped candle image with your favorite markers, Gelatos, watercolor pencils, inks, etc.
11. Fold along the score lines with the stamped side facing out. Insert the shade into the frame.
12. Remove the pull tab from the light to activate the battery, and turn the switch on. Insert the light into the base.
13. Score, mark, stamp and color the remaining three *Translucent Shades* to feature summer, winter and fall seasons. Interchange by season and enjoy throughout the year!
