### *Fraction to Decimal Conversions*

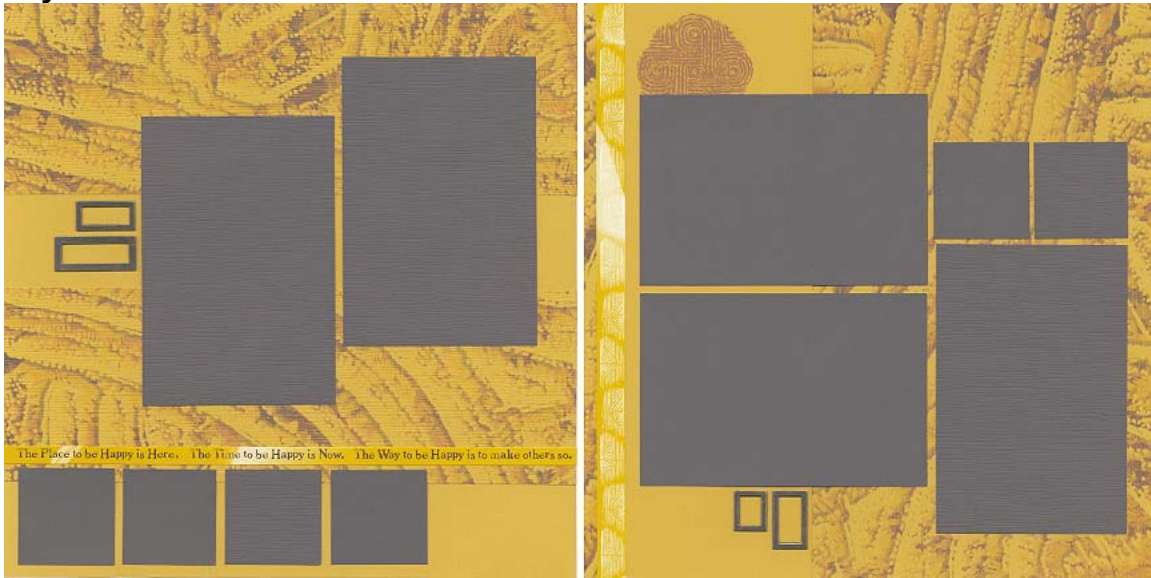
$1/8" = .125"$   $1/2" = .5"$   $7/8" = .875"$

$1/4" = .25"$   $5/8" = .625"$

$3/8" = .375"$   $3/4" = .75"$

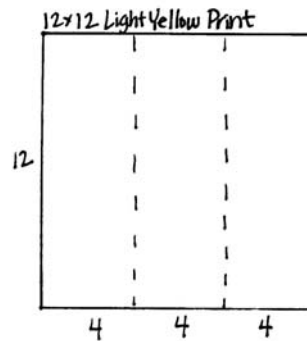


**Layout #1 and #2**

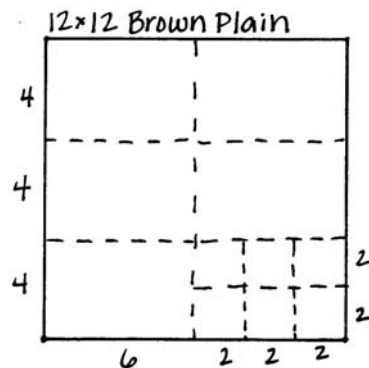


- (2) 12x12 Light Yellow Print
- 12x12 Yellow Plain
- 12x12 Brown Plain
- (4) Brass Rectangle Frames
- Sepia Ink
- Large Wood Mounted Stamp
- Stickers

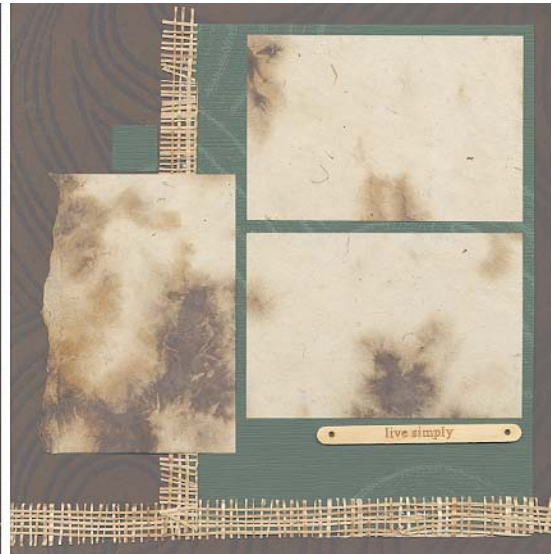
1. Trim the 12x12 Light Yellow Print at 8 and 4”.



2. Cut the 12x12 Brown Plain at 6”. Stack and rotate the 6x12 pieces horizontally and trim at 8 and 4”. Place one 4x6 into the trimmer vertically and cut at 2”. Stack the two 2x6 strips horizontally and trim at 4 and 2”.



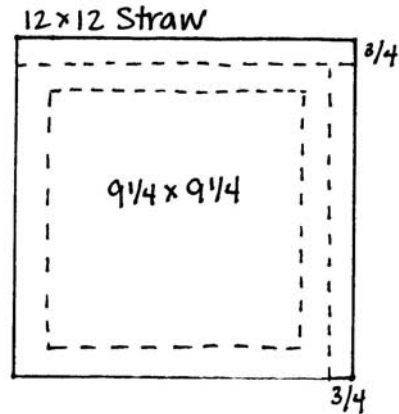
### Layout #3 and #4



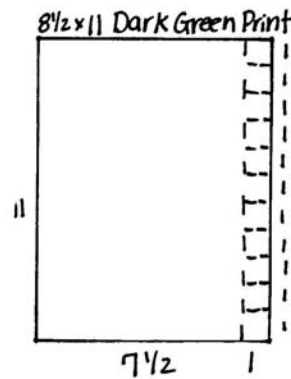
- 12x12 Brown Plain
- 12x12 Brown Print
- 12x12 Handmade Deckle
- 12x12 Natural Straw
- 8.5x11 Dark Green Print
- Stick Around Popsicle Sticks
- Craft Knife and Ruler
- Cutting Mat
- Pencil



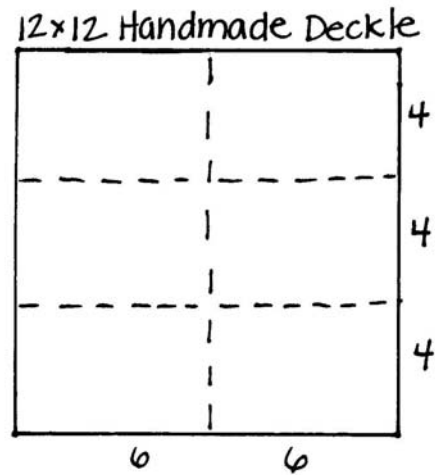
1. Trim the 12x12 Natural Straw at 11.25"; rotate and trim again at 11.75". Measure 1" in around all four sides of the Straw piece and mark with a pencil. Follow the marks with a craft knife to cut out the 9.25x9.25 middle of the frame.



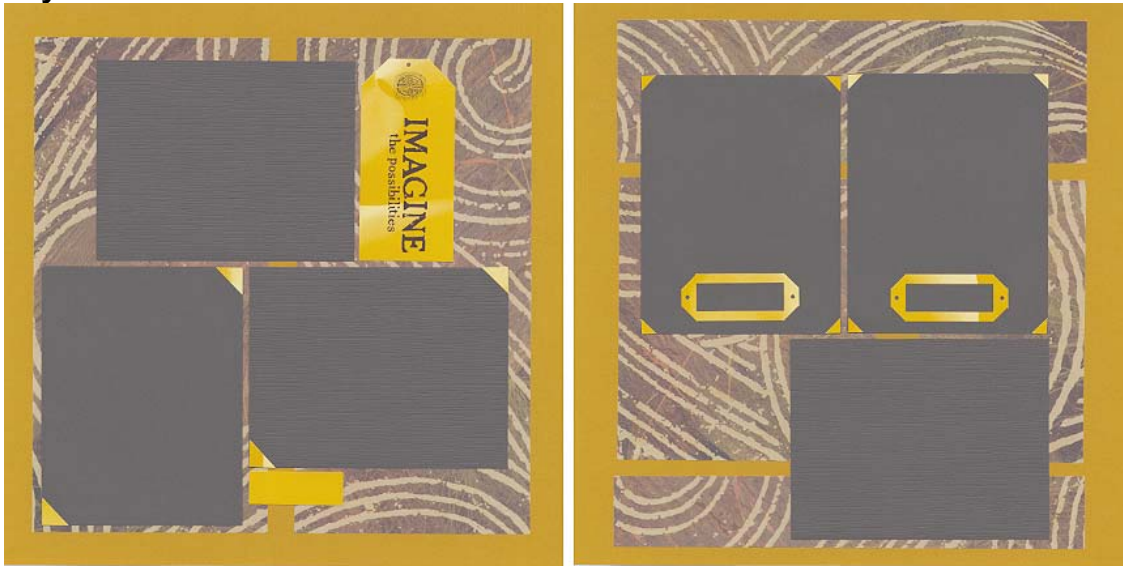
2. Cut the 8.5x11 Dark Green Print vertically at 7.5". Place the 1x11 horizontally into the trimmer; cut at 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, 1".



3. Trim the 12x12 Handmade Deckle at 6". Stack and rotate horizontally; cut at 8 and 4".

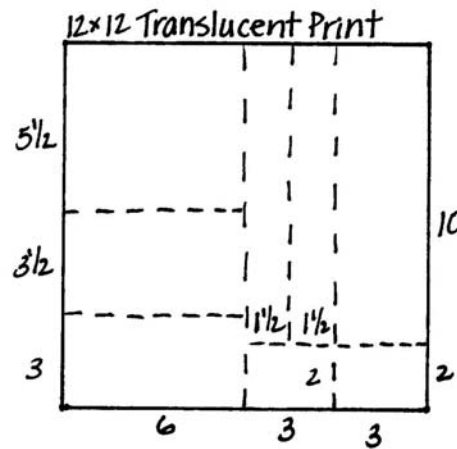


### Layout #5 and #6

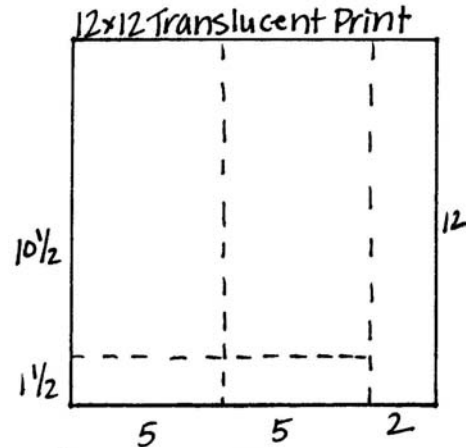


- (2) 12x12 Dark Yellow Plain
- (2) 12x12 Translucent Print
- (2) 8.5x11 Brown Plain
- Stickers

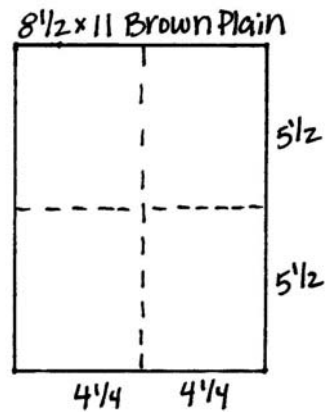
1. Trim one 12x12 Translucent Print at 9 and 6". Rotate the 6x12 horizontally and cut at 9 and 5.5". Stack both 3x12 horizontally and trim at 10". Cut one 3x10 vertically in half at 1.5".



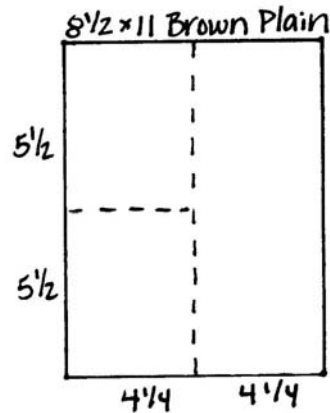
- Cut the other 12x12 Translucent Print at 10 and 5". Stack both 5x12 and rotate horizontally; trim at 10.5".



- Place one 8.5x11 Brown Plain into the trimmer and cut vertically at 4.25". Stack and rotate horizontally; trim at 5.5".

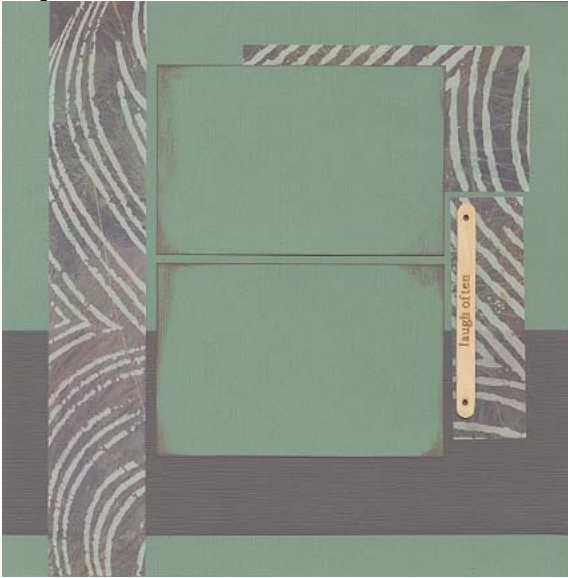


- Trim the remaining 8.5x11 Brown Plain vertically at 4.25." Rotate one 4.25x11 horizontally and cut at 5.5".



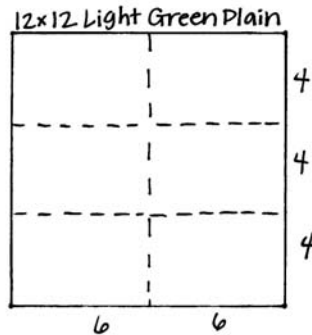


**Layout #7 and #8**

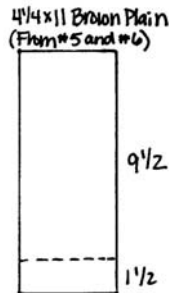


- (2) 12x12 Green Plain
- 12x12 Brown Print
- 4.25x11 Brown Plain (Layout #5 and #6)
- 2x12 Translucent Print (Layout #5 and #6)
- 1.5x10 Translucent Print (Layout #5 and #6)
- 3x6 Translucent Print (Layout #5 and #6)
- 2x3 Translucent Print (Layout #5 and #6)
- (2) 1.5x5 Translucent Print (Layout #5 and #6)
- Sepia Ink
- Stick Around Popsicle Sticks

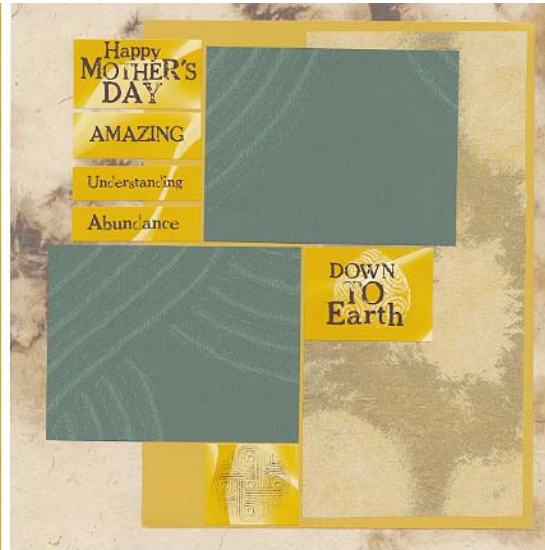
1. Trim one 12x12 Green Plain at 6". Stack and rotate horizontally and cut at 8 and 4".



2. Place the 4.25x11 Brown Plain horizontally into the trimmer; cut at 9.5".

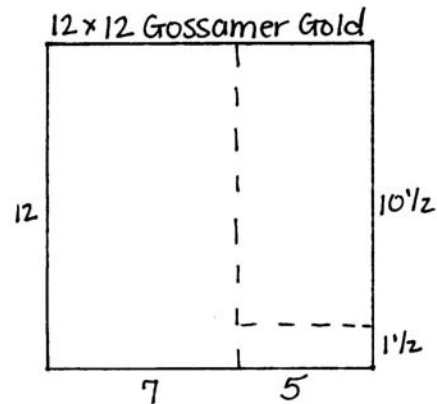


**Layout #9 and #10**

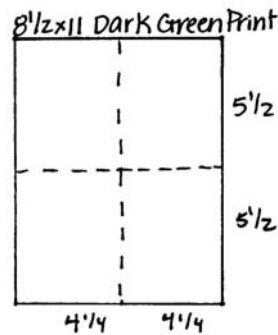


- 12x12 Light Yellow Plain
  - 12x12 Handmade Deckle
  - 12x12 Gossamer Gold
  - 8.5x11 Dark Green Print
  - 8.5x11 Light Yellow Plain
- 4x6 Light Green Photo Matte (Layout #7 and #8)
  - Stickers

1. Trim the 12x12 Gossamer Gold at 7". Rotate the 5x12 horizontally and cut at 10.5".



2. Cut the 8.5x11 Dark Green Print vertically at 4.25". Stack and rotate horizontally; trim at 5.5".



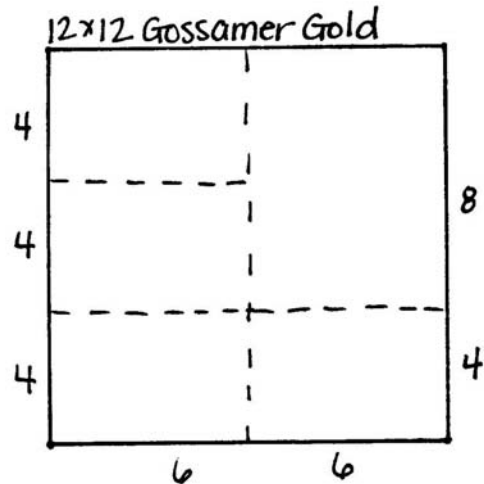


### Layout #11 and #12

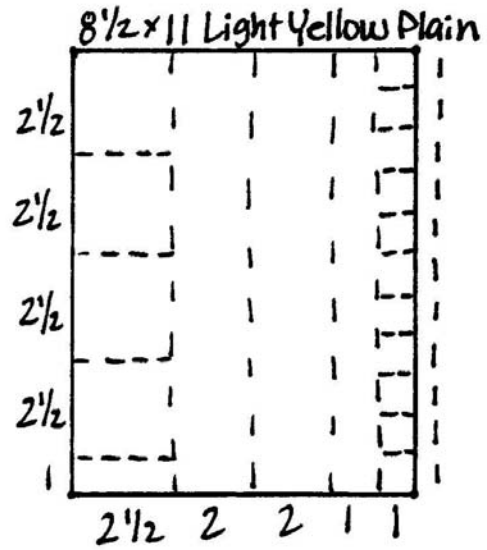


- (2) 12x12 Dark Yellow Prints
- 12x12 Gossamer Gold
- (2) 8.5x11 Dark Yellow Prints
- 8.5x11 Light Yellow Plain
- Small Wood Mounted Stamp
- Black Ink
- Stickers

1. Trim the 12x12 Gossamer Gold at 6". Rotate the 6x12 horizontally and cut at 8". Trim the other 6x12 horizontally at 8 and 4".



- Cut the 8.5x11 Light Yellow Plain vertically at 7.5, 6.5, 4.5, and 2.5". Rotate the 2.5x11 horizontally and trim at 10, 7.5, 5, and 2.5".



- Stamp one 1x11 Yellow Plain with the small wood mounted stamp and Black ink in a continuous pattern. Trim the 1x11 horizontally at 10, 9, 8, 7, 6, 5, 4, 3, 2, and 1" to make eleven 1" stamped squares.
