Fraction to Decimal Conversions

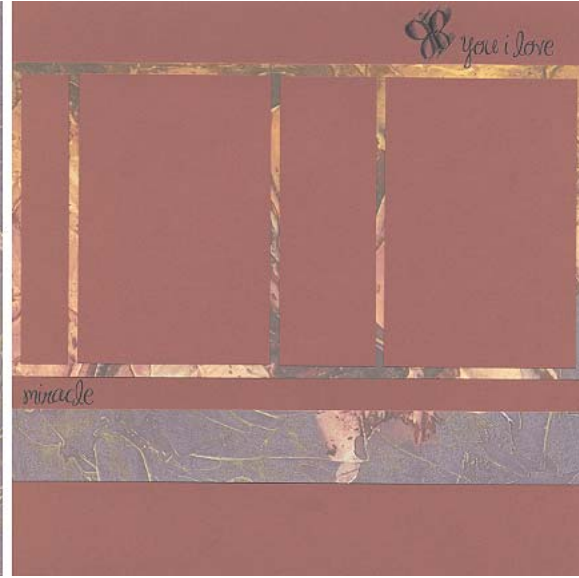
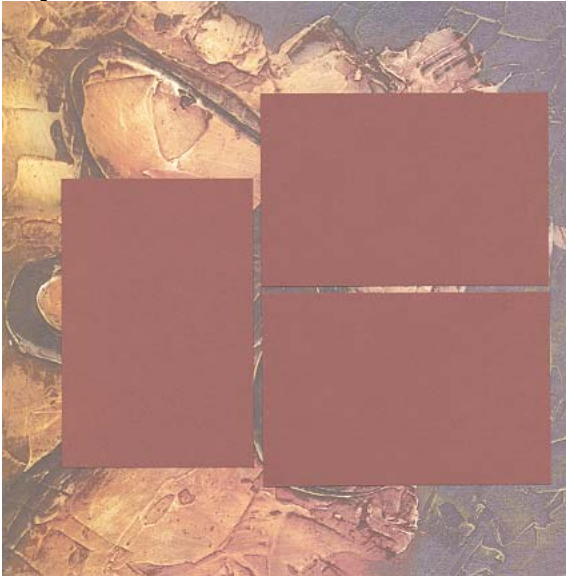
$1/8" = .125"$ $1/2" = .5"$ $7/8" = .875"$

$3/8" = .375"$ $3/4" = .75"$

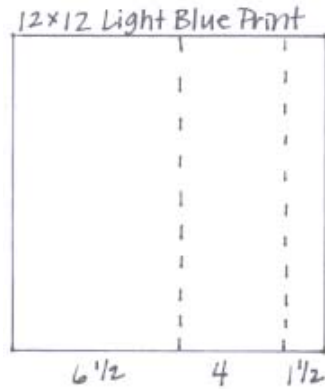


Layout #1 and #2

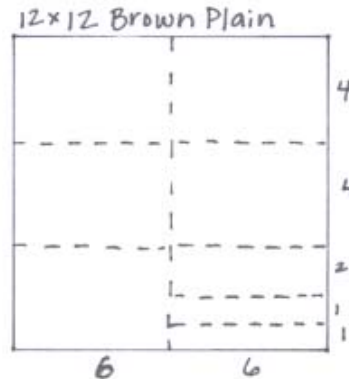


- (2) 12x12 Light Blue Print
- (2) 12x12 Brown Plain
- Whimsical Wings Rub-Ons

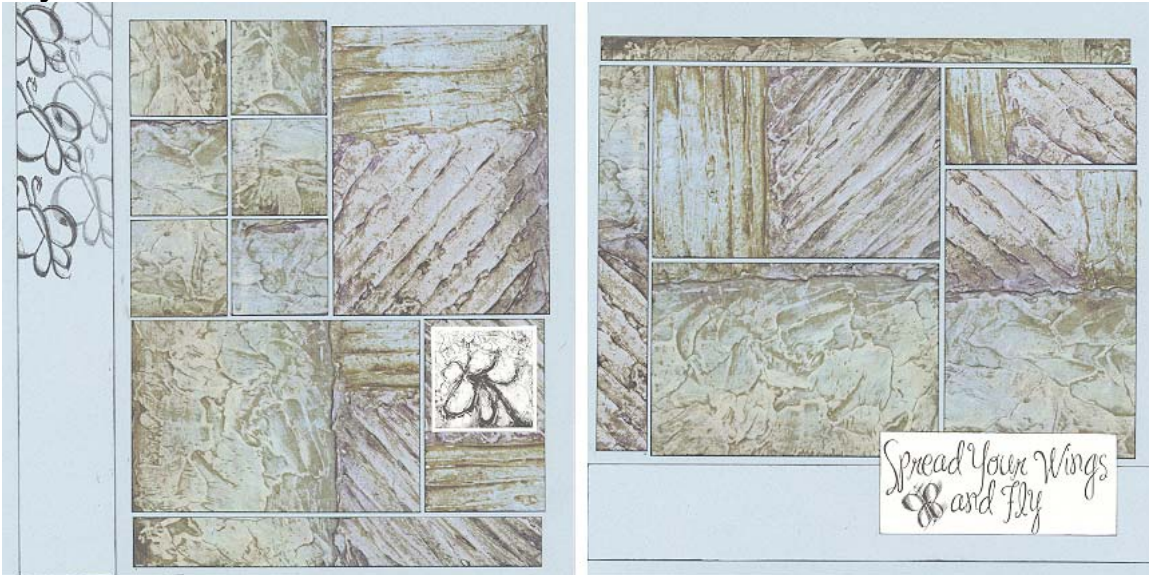
1. Trim one 12x12 Light Blue Print at 10.5 and 6.5”.



2. Cut one 12x12 Brown Plain in half at 6”. Stack and rotate the 6x12 horizontally; trim at 8 and 4”. Place one 4x6 Brown Plain into the trimmer vertically; cut at 3 and 2”.

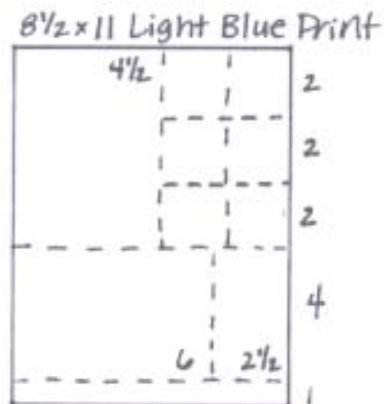


Layout #3 and #4

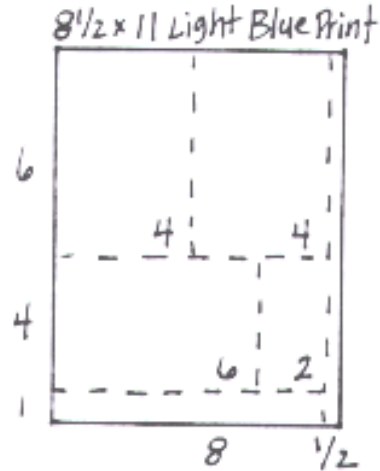


- (2) 12x12 Light Blue Plain
- (2) 8.5x11 Light Blue Print
- 4x12 Light Blue Print (From Layout #1 and #2)
- Wood Mounted "Fluttery Butterfly" Stamp
- Wings Layout Recipe Card
- Wings Borders & Backgrounds Recipe Card
- Black Ink

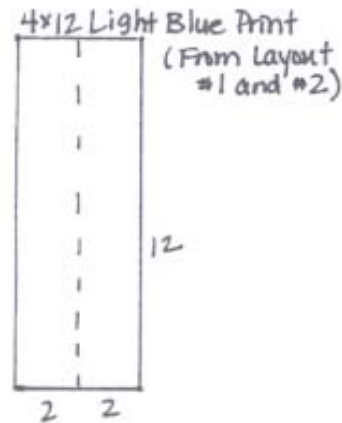
1. Trim one 8.5x11 Light Blue Print horizontally at 10 and 6". Rotate the 6x8.5 horizontally; cut at 6.5 and 4.5". Stack both 2x6 horizontally and trim at 4 and 2". Trim the 4x8.5 horizontally at 6".



- Cut the other 8.5x11 Light Blue Print vertically at 8". Rotate the 8x11 horizontally; trim at 10 and 6". Cut the 6x8 horizontally at 4". Trim the 4x8 horizontally at 6".



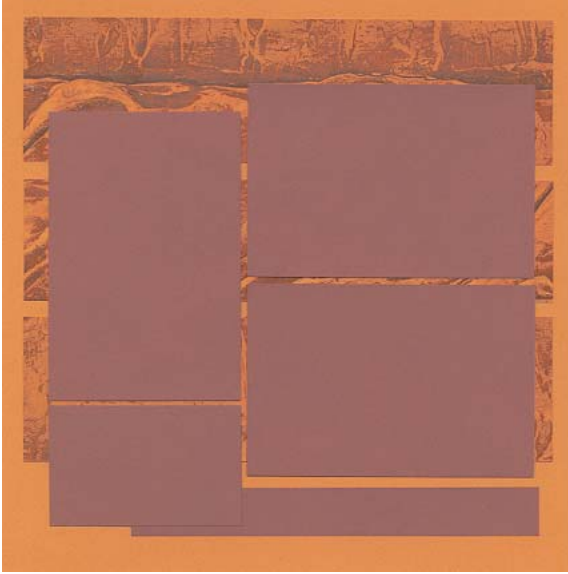
- Trim the 4x12 Light Blue Print vertically in half at 2".



- Cut out "Spread Your Wings and Fly" from the Layout Recipe Card and the Dragon Fly image from the Backgrounds and Borders.
- Stamp the butterfly image with Black Ink several times vertically onto the PLAIN side of one 2x12 Light Blue Print strip.
- Ink the edges of all the pieces with black ink to add dimension.

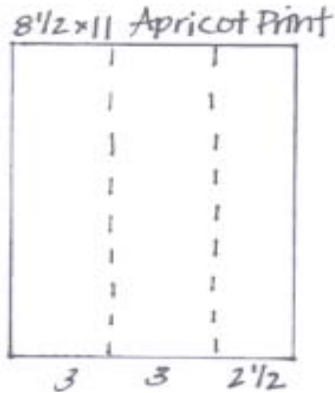


Layout #5 and #6

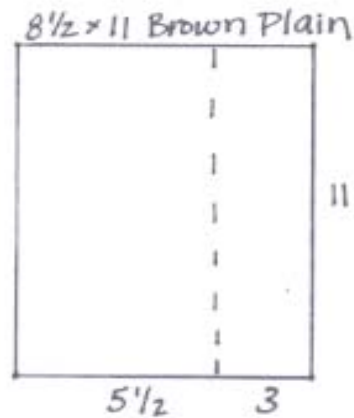


- (2) 12x12 Apricot Plain
- (2) 8.5x11 Apricot Print
- (2) 8.5x11 Brown Plain

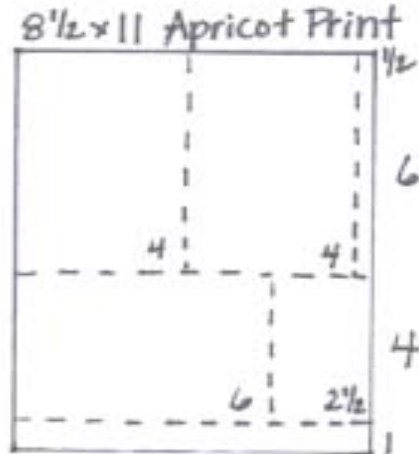
1. Trim one 8.5x11 Apricot Print vertically at 6 and 3".



2. Cut one 8.5x11 Brown Plain vertically at 5.5".



- Trim the other 8.5x11 Apricot Print horizontally at 10 and 6". Rotate the 6x8.5 horizontally and cut at 8 and 4". Place the 4x8.5 horizontally into the trimmer; trim at 6".



- Repeat the same cutting steps listed in Step Three with the remaining 8.5x11 Brown Plain.

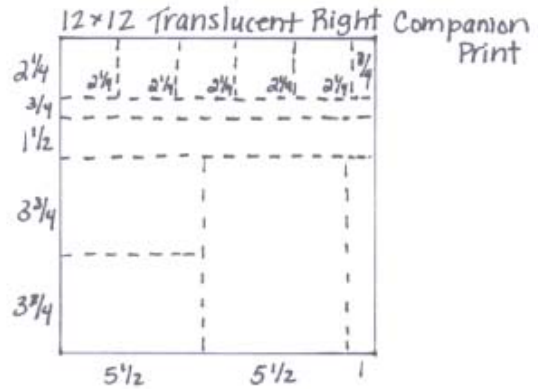


Layout #7 and #8

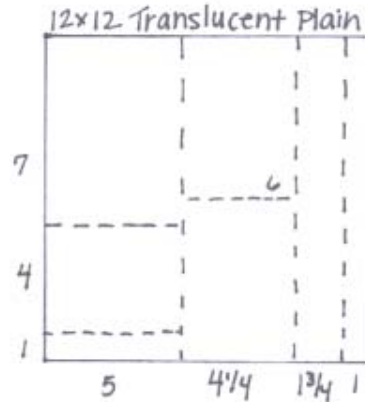


- (2) 12x12 Light Blue Plain
- 12x12 Translucent Right Companion Print
- 12x12 White Translucent Plain
- Whimsical Wings Rub-Ons

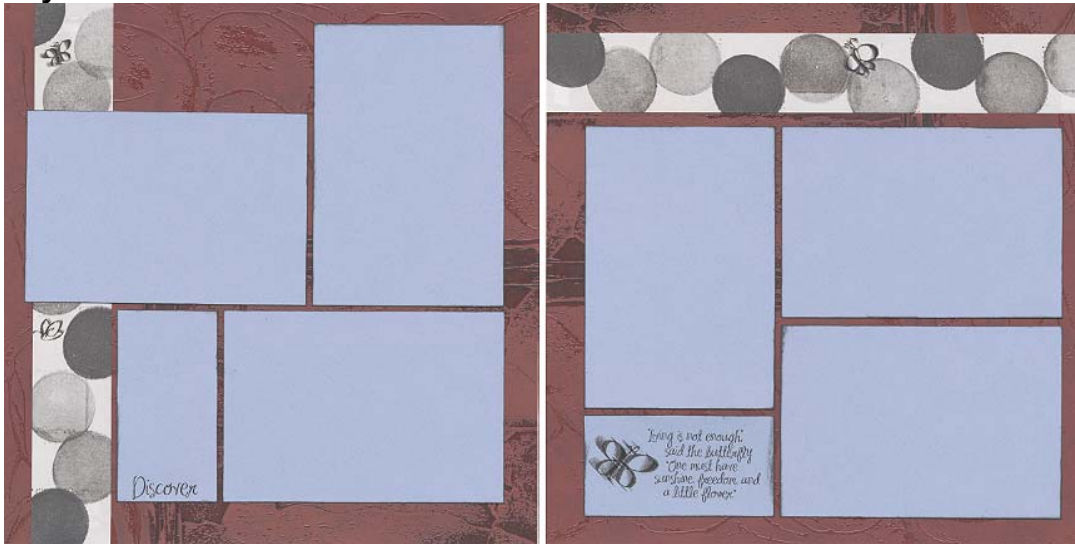
1. Trim the 12x12 Translucent Print at 9.75, 9, and 7.5". Trim the 7.5 x12 horizontally at 11 and 5.5". Rotate one 5.5x7.5 horizontally and trim at 3.75". Cut the 2.25x12 strip horizontally at 11.25, 9, 6.75, 4.5, and 2.25".



2. Trim the 12x12 Translucent Plain at 11, 9.25, and 5". Rotate the 5x12 horizontally and cut at 11 and 7". Cut the 4.25x12 horizontally in half at 6".

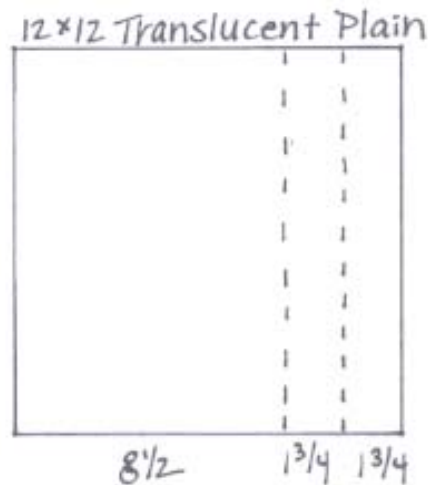


Layout #9 and #10

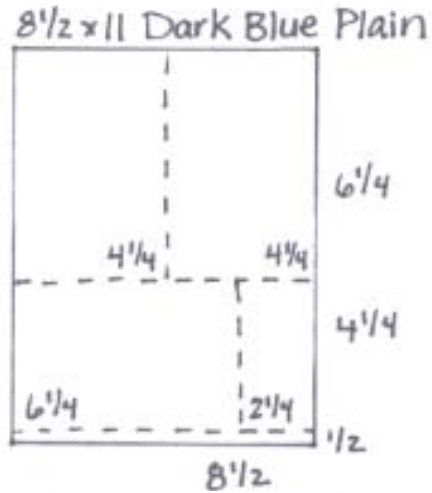


- (2) 12x12 Brown Print
- 12x12 Translucent Plain
- (2) 8.5x11 Dark Blue Plain
- Wood Mounted "Moon Shadow" Stamp
- Whimsical Wings Rub-Ons
- Black Ink

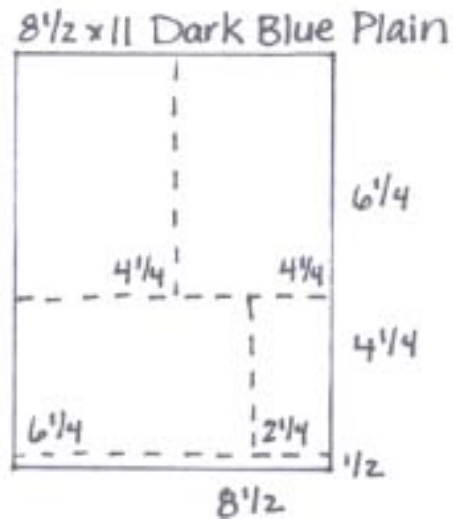
1. Trim the 12x12 Translucent Plain at 10.25 and 8.5".



- Cut one 8.5x11 Dark Blue Plain horizontally at 10.5 and 6.25". Rotate the 6.25x8.5 horizontally and trim at 4.25". Cut the 4.25x8.5 horizontally at 6.25".



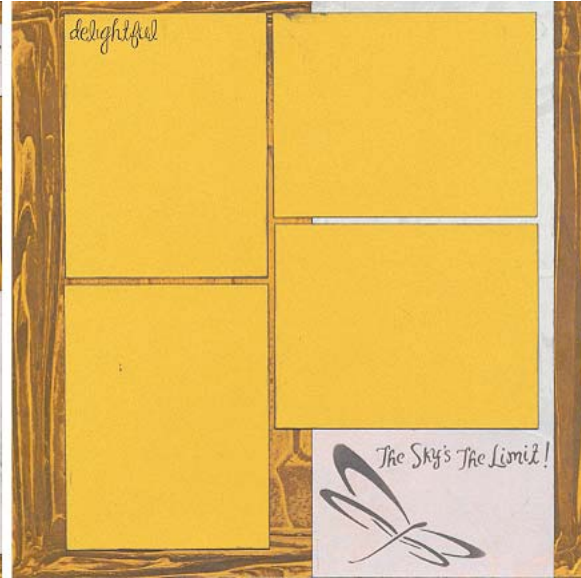
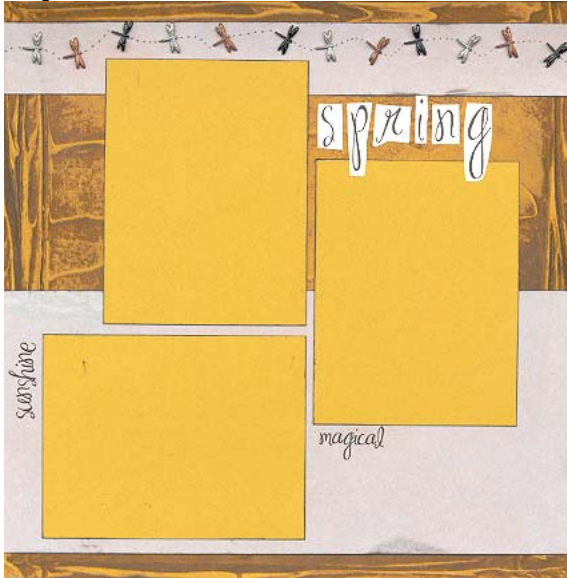
- Repeat the same cutting instructions as listed in Step Two with the other 8.5x11 Dark Blue Plain.



- Stamp the circle image with black ink onto the 1.75x12" Translucent strips.
- Ink the edges of the Dark Blue pieces with black ink.



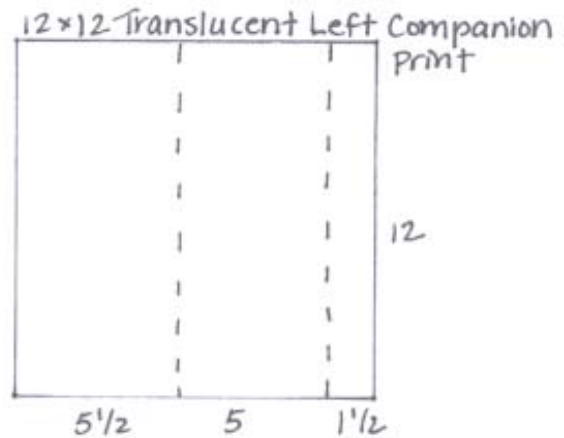
Layout #11 and #12



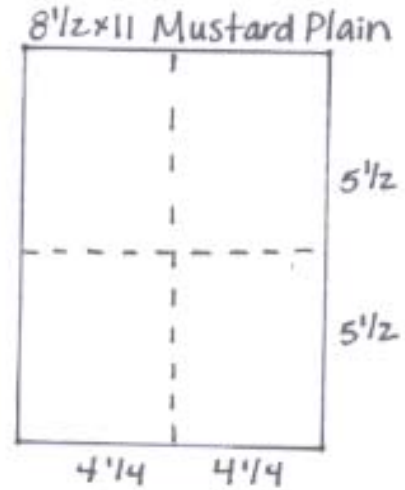
- (2) 12x12 Mustard Print
- 12x12 Translucent Left Companion Print
- (2) 8.5x11 Mustard Plain
- Black Marker
- 12 Dragonfly Brads
- Wings Font Recipe Card

- Whimsical Wings Rub-Ons
- Tri-fold Card Stencil
- Black Ink
- Stylus Tool
- Paper Piercing Tool
- Cork Board

1. Trim the 12x12 Translucent Print at 10.5 and 5.5".



- Cut two 8.5x11 Mustard Plain vertically in half at 4.25". Stack and rotate horizontally; trim in half at 5.5".



- Cut "spring" from the Wings fonts.
- Stencil the Dragonfly and "The Sky's The Limit" with the stylus tool and Black ink.
- Attach the dragonfly brads in a wavy pattern across the plain side of the 1.5x12 Translucent Print. Add black dots with a marker to show them all flying in line.
