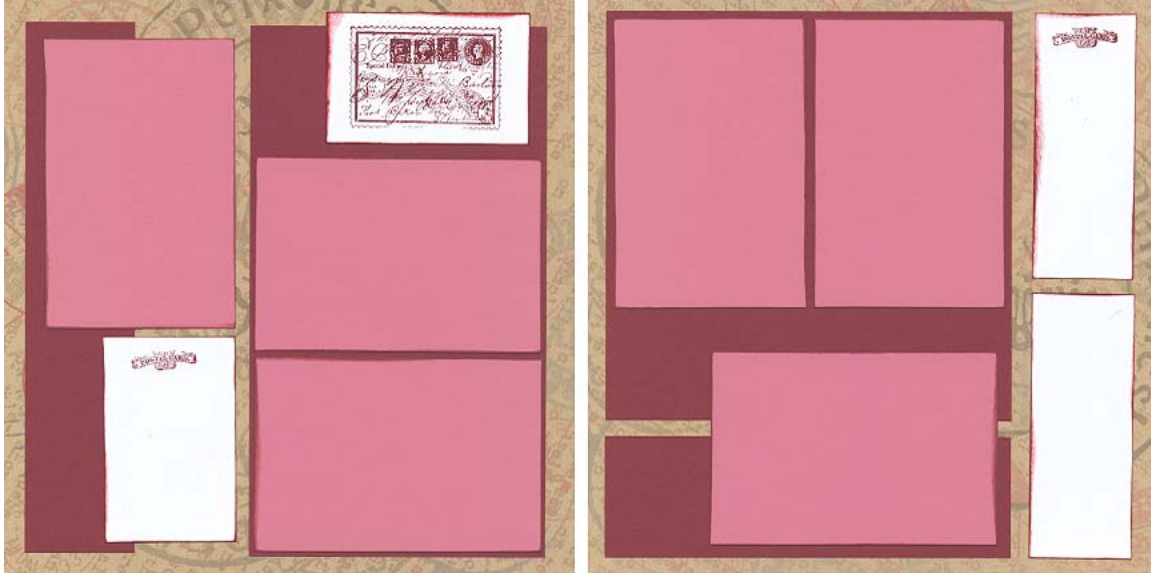

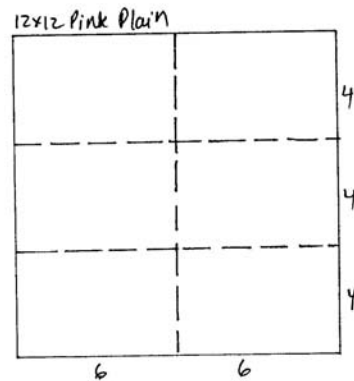
Layout #1 and #2

Formulas: Mathematic Matting and 8.5x11 Horizontal/Vertical Split

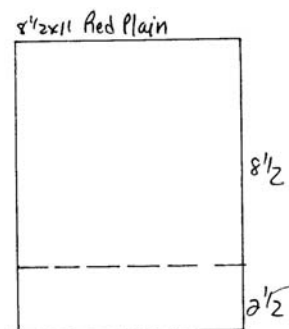


- (2) 12x12 Kraft Print
- (2) 8.5x11 Red Plain
- 12x12 Pink Plain
- 8.5x11 White Perforated Notecards
- Red Chalk-a-lot Ink
- TYWL Wood Mounted Stamps

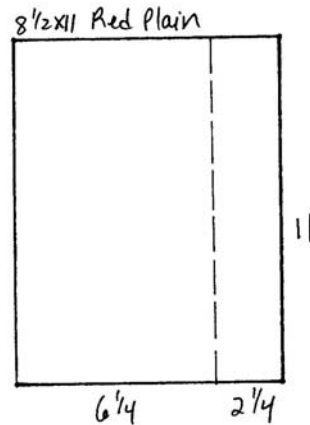
1. Place the 12x12 Pink Plain into the trimmer and cut at 6." Stack the two 6x12 pieces and place horizontally into the trimmer; cut at 8" and 4."



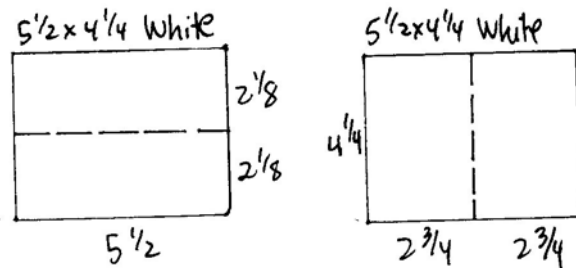
2. Insert one 8.5x11 Red Plain horizontally into the trimmer and cut at 8.5."



- Place the second 8.5x11 Red Plain vertically into the trimmer and cut at 6.25."



- Carefully fold and tear two 4.25x5.5 white note cards from the perforated sheet. Trim one in half vertically at 2-1/8." Trim the other in half horizontally at 2.75."



- Ink the edges of all six 4x6 Pink Plain photo mattes and the four white pieces with red ink.
- Layer the 2.25x11 Red Plain strip vertically along the left edge of the 12x12 Kraft Print, centering from top to bottom. Place the 6.25x11 Red in alignment along the right edge.
- Place two 4x6 Pink photo mattes onto the lower right corner of the page, and one vertical Pink matte into the upper left corner.
- Stamp "post card" onto the top vertical center of the 2.75x4.25 White panel with red ink and attach to the lower left corner of the page.
- Stamp the postage collage onto the horizontal center of the 2.75x4.25 White panel with red ink and layer onto the top right corner of the layout.
- Place the 8.5x8.5 Red Plain onto the upper left corner of the remaining 12x12 Kraft Print. Layer the 2.5x8.5 Red Plain beneath the square. Maintain equal spacing between the two pieces and from the top and bottom edge.
- Layer two vertical and one horizontal 4x6 Pink photo matte onto the layout within the Red Plain paper.
- Stamp "post card" onto the top vertical center of the 2-1/8x5.5" White panel and place onto the top right corner of the page. Layer the second piece in the lower right corner.

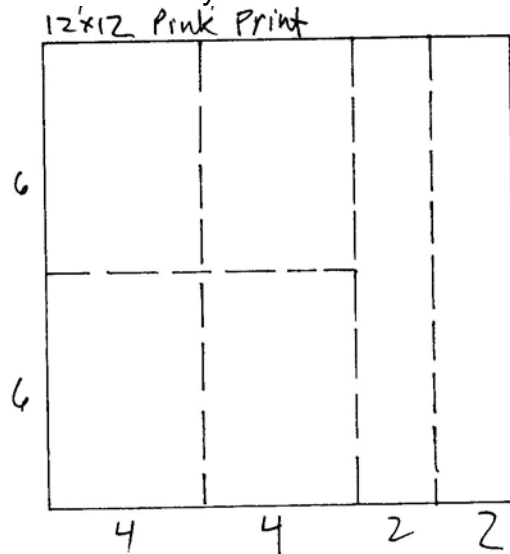
Layout #3 and #4

Techniques: 8's in the Gutter; Mattes 'n Borders

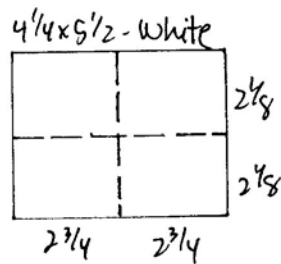


- (2) 12x12 Red Plain
- 12x12 Pink Print
- (2) 8.5x11 White Postage Print
- 8.5x11 Pink Alphabet Print
- 4.25x5.5 White Perforated Note Card
- Red Ink

1. Trim the 12x12 Pink Print at 10, 8, and 4". Place the 4x12 pieces horizontally into the trimmer at 6" and trim to create four 4x6 photo mattes.



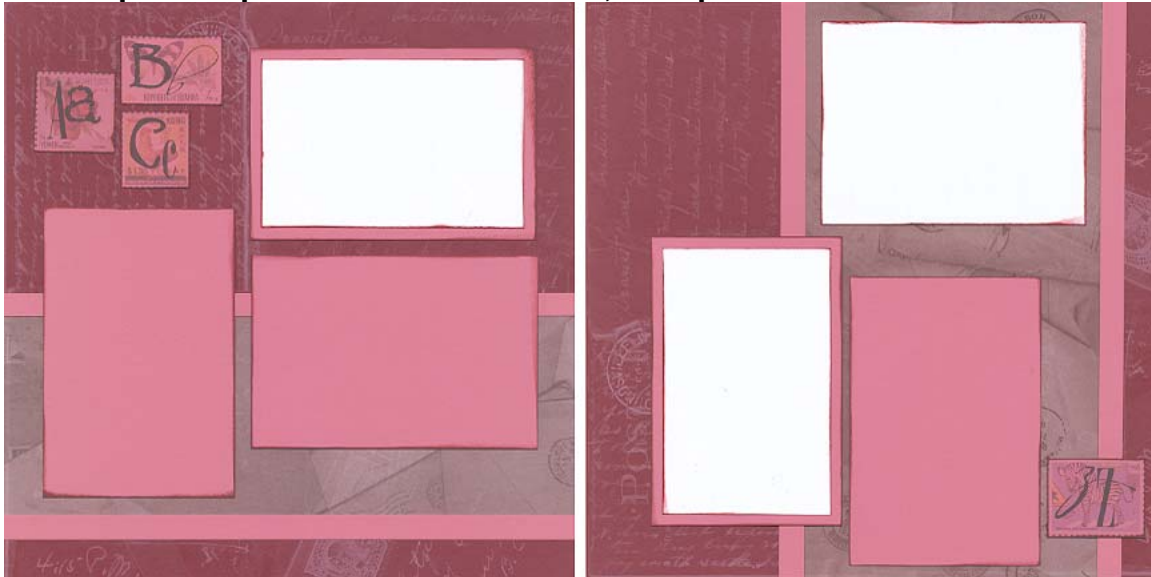
- Cut the 4.25x5.5 White note card horizontally in half at 2.75." Place the two 2.75x4.25 pieces horizontally into the trimmer and cut in half again at 2-1/8."



- Ink the edges of all Pink Print pieces, the two 8.5x11 White Postage Prints, and the four White pieces with red ink. *Tip: Use caution when inking the die cut postage print. The edges of the paper can damage the surface of the inkpad.*
- Position the 2x12 Pink Print vertically onto the 12x12 Red Plain, about .5" from the left edge.
- Layer the 8.5x11 White Postage Print vertically onto the right side of the page with a consistent margin on all sides.
- Place two horizontal 4x6 Pink Print photo mattes onto the lower right side of the White Print.
- Place the 2.75x2-1/8 White horizontally onto the top left corner of the page. Trim a letter of choice from the 8.5x11 Alphabet Print and layer onto the White panel.
- Recreate a "mirror" of the same layout for the right side of the spread. Position the 2x12 Pink Print border vertically on the right edge of the remaining 12x12 Red Plain. Center the second 8.5x11 White Print into the open area. Layer two vertical 4x6 Pink Print photo mattes into the upper right corner of the page.
- Attach a row of three vertical 2.75x2-1/8 White rectangles along the bottom left edge of the layout. Select three alphabet letters from the 8.5x11 Pink Alphabet print; layer onto the three squares. *Tip: "J-O-Y" is a great 3-letter word appropriate for most any scrapbook page! Both pages of this spread can be easily rotated prior to adding the letters.*

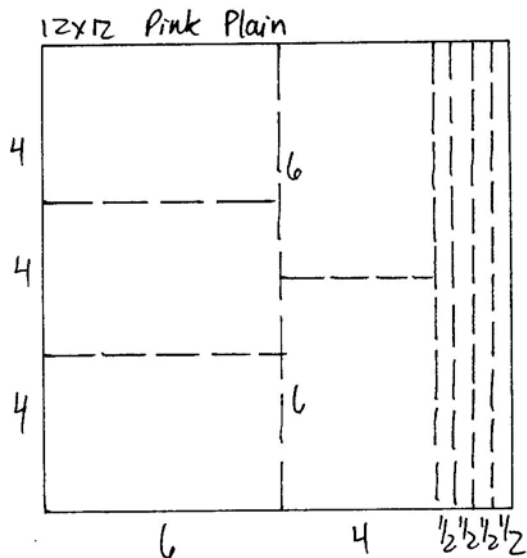
Layout #5 and #6

Techniques: Paper Ribbons and Mattes; 5/7 Split

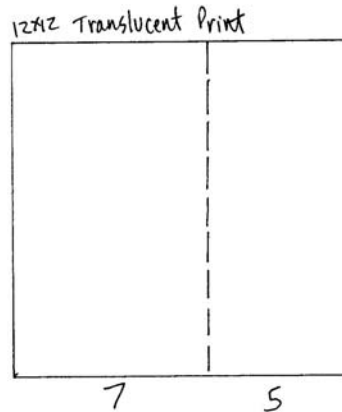


- (2) 12x12 Red Print
- 12x12 Translucent Print
- 12x12 Pink Plain
- 8.5x11 Pink Alphabet Print (from Layout #3 and #4)
- 8.5x11 White Perforated Note Cards
- Red Ink

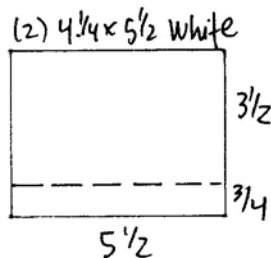
1. Trim the 12x12 Pink Plain at 11.5, 11, 10.5, 10 and 6." Place the 4x12 piece horizontally into the trimmer at cut at 6." Trim the 6x12 piece horizontally at 8 and 4". This will make four .5x12 strips and five photo mattes.



- Cut the 12x12 Pink Translucent at 7."



- Place two pieces of 5.5x4.25 White perforated note cards vertically into the trimmer and trim at 3.5."



- Place the 5x12 Pink Translucent Print horizontally along the bottom edge of the 12x12 Red Print, approximately 1.5" from the bottom edge. Cover the top and bottom edge of the Translucent with two .5x12 strips of Pink Plain. Tip: *This is a great way to cover the visible adhesive holding the Translucent paper in place.*
- Ink the edges of three 4x6 Pink mattes and one 3.5x5.5 White matte with red ink. Layer two horizontal and one Pink matte onto the page. Nest the White matte into the Pink piece at the upper right corner of the page.
- Choose a few letters from the 8.5x11 Pink Alphabet Print, ink edges with red ink, and layer onto the top left corner of the layout.
- Place the 7x12 Pink Translucent Print vertically onto the right side of the remaining 12x12 Red Print, about 1" from the edge. Cover the edges of the translucent paper with two .5x12 Pink strips.
- Ink the edges of two 4x6 Pink photo mattes and place vertically onto the page. Ink the edges of a 3.5x5.5 White panel and nest into the left Pink matte.
- Ink the edges of a 4.25x5.5 White note card and place horizontally into the upper right corner of the layout.
- Choose an additional letter from the 8.5x11 Pink Alphabet print, ink edges, and layer onto the right bottom corner to finish.
