

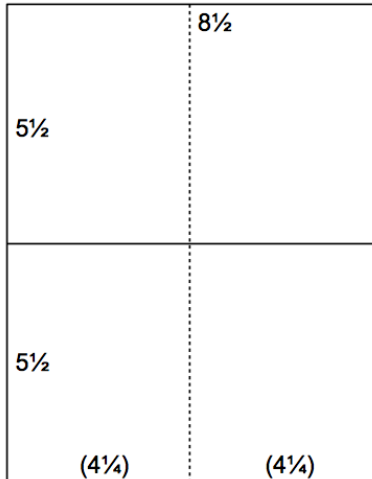


Assembly Line Cardmaking

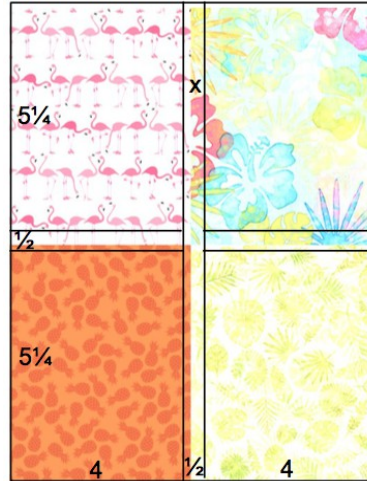
Trimming and scoring instructions for the *Paradise Club Stamp* paper collection:
(Makes 10 cards.)

8½x11 White Print, Pink Plain,
and Lime Plain



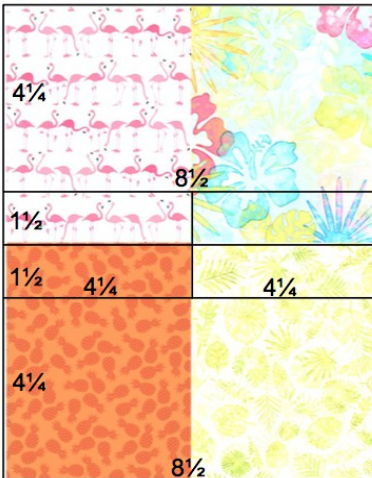
1. Score one 8.5x11 White Print, one Pink Plain and one Lime Plain vertically at 4.25". Trim horizontally at 5.5". Fold each 5.5x8.5 in half on the score line.

8½x11 Quad Print



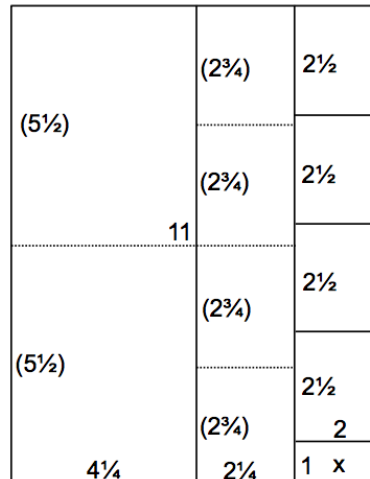
2. Trim one 8.5x11 Quad Print vertically at 4.5 and 4". Cut each 4x11 horizontally at 5.75 and 5.25".

8½x11 Quad Print



3. Trim one 8.5x11 Quad Print horizontally at 6.75, 5.5 and 4.25". Trim each 1.5x8.5 horizontally at 4.25".

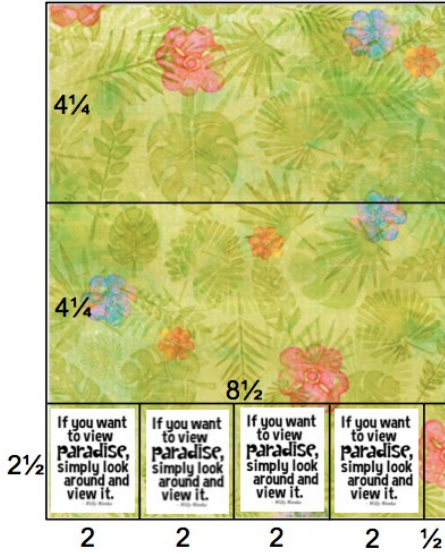
8½x11 Black, White, Blue,
and Pink Plains



4. Trim one 8.5x11 Black, one White, one Blue and one Pink Plain vertically at 6.5 and 4.25". Score and fold the 4.25x11 horizontally at 5.5". Score and accordion fold the 2.25x11 horizontally at 2.75, 5.5 and 8.25". Trim the 2x11 horizontally at 10, 7.5, 5 and 2.5".

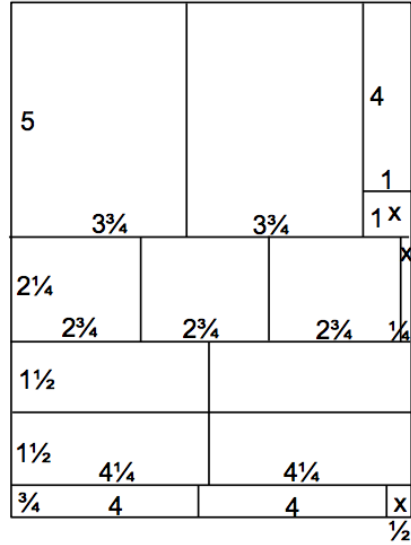


8½x11 White Print



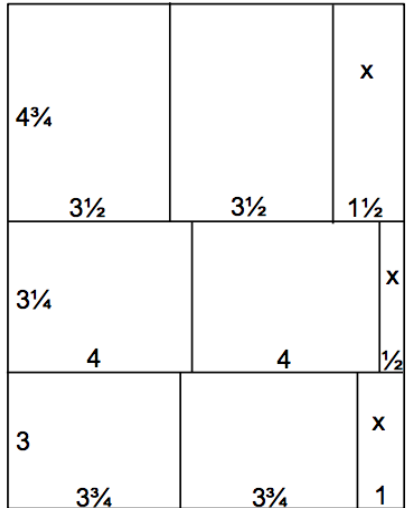
5. Trim one 8.5x11 White Print horizontally at 8.5 and 4.25". Cut the 2.5x8.5 horizontally at 8, 6, 4 and 2". Stamp the "paradise" sentiment onto the 2x2.5 panels with black ink. Use the 4.25x8.5 pieces to create two pop-up mechanisms. (Visit link below to view video.)

8½x11 Black Plain



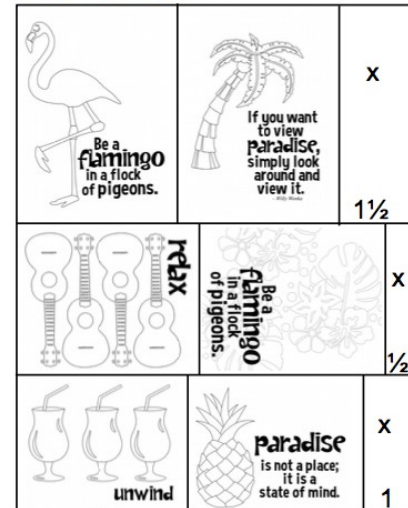
6. Trim one 8.5x11 Black Plain horizontally at 10.25, 8.75, 7.25, and 5". Cut the 5x8.5 horizontally at 7.5 and 3.75". Trim the 1x5 horizontally at 4". Cut the 2.25x8.5 horizontally at 8.25, 5.5 and 2.75". Trim each 1.5x8.5 horizontally at 4.25". Cut the .75x8.5 horizontally at 8 and 4".

8½x11 White Plain



7. Trim one 8.5x11 White Plain horizontally at 8.25 and 5". Cut the 5x8.5 horizontally at 7 and 3.5". Trim the 3.25x8.5 horizontally at 8 and 4". Cut the 3x8.5 horizontally at 7.5 and 3.75". Stamp each panel as shown in the diagram at right. (Consult the blog for additional inking and color details.)
