



mini maze in a matchbook

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
Materials

- $3\frac{5}{8} \times 3\frac{1}{8}$ " Matchbook Tray
- $1\frac{7}{8} \times 4\frac{5}{8}$ " Sleeve
- 5x7" Maze Book
- $1\frac{3}{4} \times 2\frac{7}{8}$ " Maze Book Cover
- Mini Brad
- 9" Waxed Linen Thread
- Printed Cutparts and Matting Paper

Tools and Supplies

- ScorePal
- Bone Folder
- Scissors
- CS® Bookbinding Glue
- Needle-tipped Applicator
- Piercing Awl
- Cork Board

Assembly Instructions

1. Score the $3\frac{5}{8} \times 3\frac{1}{8}$ " Matchbook Tray $\frac{3}{8}$ and $\frac{7}{8}$ " from each outside edge.
2. Score the $1\frac{7}{8} \times 4\frac{5}{8}$ " Sleeve horizontally at 1.5, 2, 3.5 and 4".
3. Score the 5x7" Maze Book paper horizontally at 1.75, 3.5 and 5.25". Score vertically at 1.25, 2.5 and 3.75".
4. Score the $1\frac{3}{4} \times 2\frac{7}{8}$ " Maze Book Cover horizontally at 1.25 and 1-5/8".
5. Position the $3\frac{5}{8} \times 3\frac{1}{8}$ " Matchbook Tray vertically and use a scissors to cut along the score lines as shown in the diagram to create tabs.

6. Place the Matchbook Tray vertically onto a cork board with the bumps of the score lines facing up. Pierce one hole into the center of the short wall at the bottom of the tray, and two evenly spaced holes into the short wall at the top.
7. Insert a brad into the single hole with the prongs on the side with the bump of the score lines.
8. Thread waxed linen into the two pierced holes. Enter the holes from the side with the bump of the score lines. Knot the thread tails about 1" from the ends to form a hanging loop.
9. Fold along all score lines with the bump of the score on the inside of the fold. Adhere the $\frac{3}{8}$ " long walls with CS® Bookbinding Glue in a Needle-tipped Applicator. Place the long walls at a 90° angle and turn in the four tabs. Bring the short walls up and over the tabs and adhere with glue.



10. Fold the 5x7" Maze Book paper horizontally along the score lines. Check to ensure the paper is folded exactly in half and burnish all folds with a bone folder. Fold back on the remaining two horizontal score lines. Open. Repeat folds in the other direction, being careful to make accurate folds. Open.

11. Cut along the score lines of the maze book as indicated by the solid lines in the diagram. Accordion fold to create the maze book, reversing folds as needed. If desired adhere the pages back to back to keep the book from popping open.

12. Fold along the score lines of the 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ x2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Maze Book Cover. Adhere the cover to the outside pages of the maze book. Insert the book into the tray.

13. Fold all score lines of the 1 $\frac{7}{8}$ x4 $\frac{5}{8}$ " Sleeve. Apply adhesive to the outer short tab and adhere so the tab is on the inside of the sleeve. Slide the sleeve onto the tray.

14. Trim the cutaparts into individual panels with a scissors, paper trimmer or ruler and craft knife. Mat with the contrasting paper provided in the kit, if desired.
